



Transport

Overview

- Road Transport
 - Kiribati, PNG, Solomon Islands, Timor-Leste
- Air Transport
 - PNG
- Water Transport
 - PNG

- Kiribati Road Rehabilitation Project
 - Total project cost: \$33.66 million
 - 34 km road rehabilitation
 - 1 consulting services contract to be awarded in Q1
 2011
 - 1 civil works contract to be advertized in Q2 2011 and to be awarded in Q3 2011

- PNG: Highlands Region Road Investment Program (MFF)
 - The investment program estimated in cost \$750 million will include 3-4 project loans involving about 1,100 km road rehabilitation and be implemented over a period of 10 years (completion by Dec 2018).
 - Project 1:
 - Cost: \$140 million
 - 211 km road rehabilitation
 - Expected to be completed by 2013
 - Civil works contracts for road rehabilitation and long-term performance-based maintenance are scheduled for award in 2011
 - Consulting services contract for construction supervision to be awarded in 2011
 - Consulting services contract for socio-economic monitoring study to be awarded in 2011

- Solomon Islands Transport Sector Development Project
 - Total project cost: \$24.5 million (AUS and NZL are expected to provide parallel grant cofinancing)
 - Multi-transport facility (land, air, and marine) rehabilitation and maintenance
 - Procurement of consulting services in Q2-Q4 2011
 - Geotechnical investigation and analysis,
 - Topographical and bathymetric surveys,
 - Infrastructure condition surveys and database surveys,
 - social and monitoring and evaluation surveys and data collection, and
 - IT support services
 - Procurement of Civil Works in 2012

- Timor-Leste Road Network Development (Sector) Project
 - Total project cost estimated: \$52.90 million
 - 230 km road rehabilitation and 302 km road maintenance
 - Procurement of civil works in Q2-Q4 2011

Air Transport

- PNG Civil Aviation Development Investment Program
 - Total project cost: \$480 million for TA and construction
 - Implemented as MFF over 9 years
 - Airport infrastructure and terminals, institutional reforms and private sector participation
 - Consulting services for project implementation including project management and design and supervision (selection process in progress)
 - Civil works
 - Fencing for 4 airports Alotau, Wewak, Hoskins and Goroka
 (ITB expected to be issued by Q1 2011)
 - Fire Fighting Trucks Tenders (3 units) bids to be issued Q4 2011
 - Airport Improvements Mt Hagan, Hoskins, Wewak and Gurney (designing to complete by Q3 2011 and ITB will be issued Q1 2012)

Water Transport

- PNG Lae Port Development Project
 - Total project cost: \$154 million
 - Civil works for port facilities, including dredging, berth, terminal construction
 - Civil works bid close on 16 March 2011
- PNG Proposed Second Community Water Transport Sector Project
 - Total project cost: \$35.0 million
 - Improvement of existing water transport infrastructure, implementation of infrastructure maintenance program, contribution to Community Water Transport Trust Fund
 - Recruitment of consulting services for project implementation in early 2012
