Southeast Asia Development Symposium Deep Dive Workshop

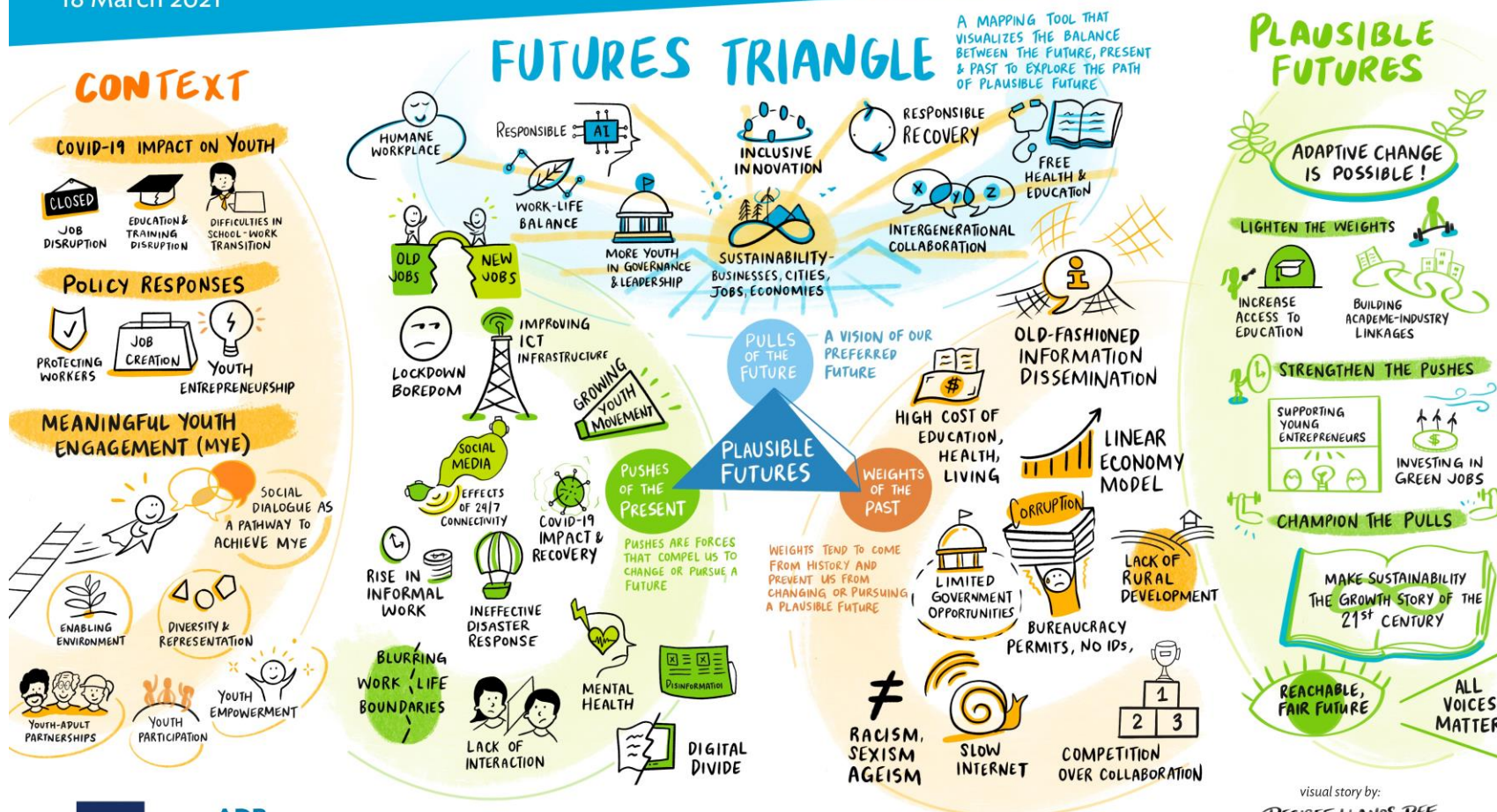
