



Concentrated decentralisation strategy with emphasis on rural-urban integration bringing jobs and economic opportunities to the locals






ECERDC has attracted a committed investment of RM163.3 billion by offering strategic infrastructure and special incentive packages






A complete infrastructure network is critical in attracting private investments in addressing the socio-economic imbalance of the ECER Region






