- lack for sharing effectively leverage such resources/values, the large and growing amount of data, information, published materials and experiences
- Citizens are not provided with the trustworthy/ scientific knowledge about the plastic issues and its impact on health.

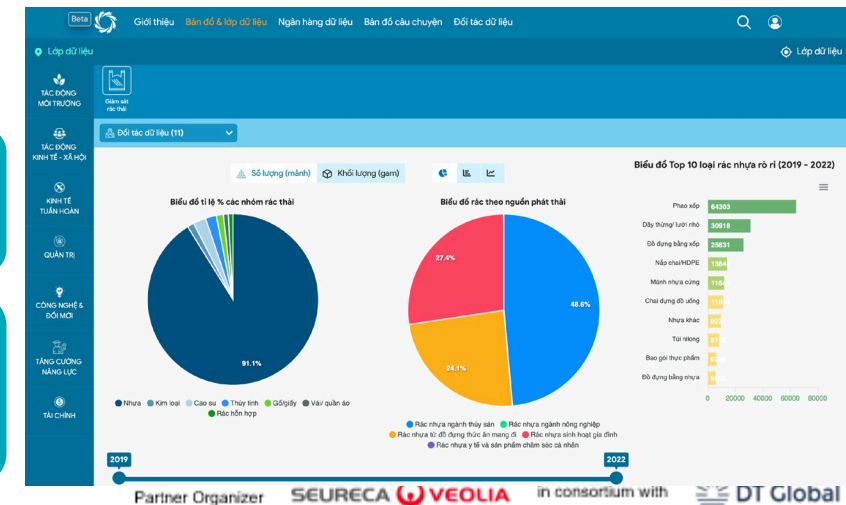
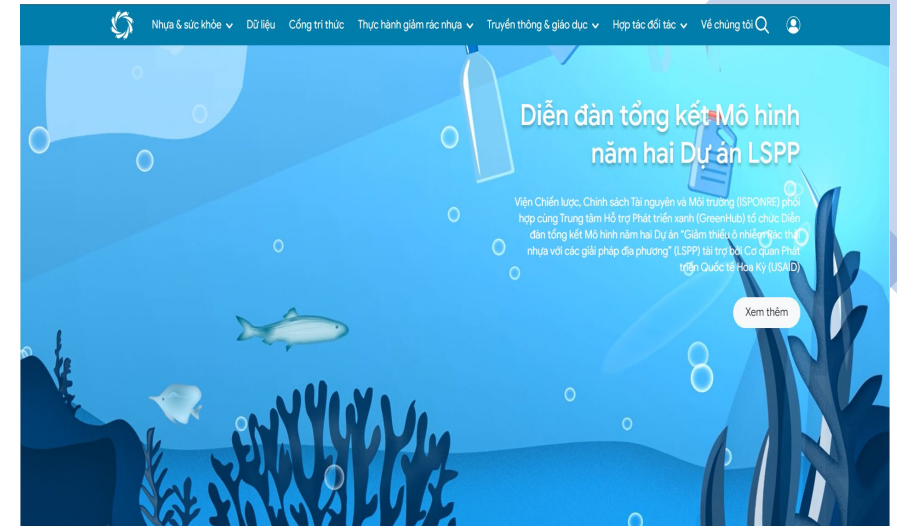
PLATFORM OBJECTIVES

A open, digital platform to enhance collaboration and serve the needs of organizations and individuals to deliver actionable content and tools through participation in design and use.

Providing knowledge about plastic pollution and the impact of plastic on human health.

Offering a database and information on plastic waste management.

Creating a forum to share knowledge, innovations, and successful experiences in reducing plastic waste.

- **Mapping programs/projects/innovations on the map of Vietnam to facilitate information retrieval and search.**

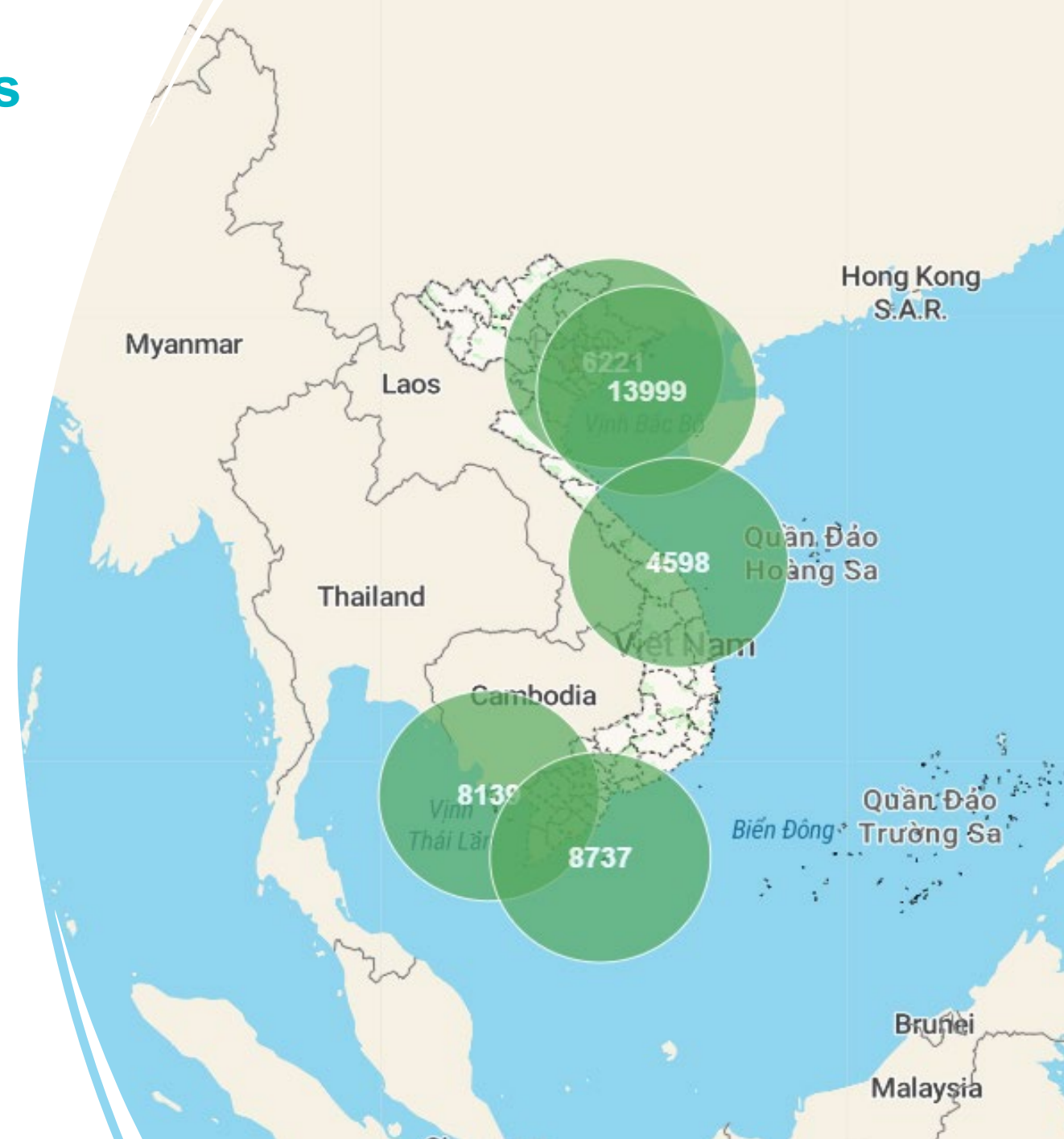


Pilot city site sub-page level

Lesson Learned

Serving Priority Information Needs

Satisfying priority information needs requires many consultations, separating “needs” from “wants”, and “personal” from “organizational” needs. Other platform developments e.g. C40, GPML are essential to consult

Content Production

Prioritizing content, maintaining responsive relationships with contributors, and documenting progress and challenges are crucial for maintaining effective content production.

Copyright and Access Rights

Determining copyright and access rights for content can be complicated and requires understanding and monitoring government legal regulations, conditions set by content providers and international standards.



Platform Sustainability



Keeping content consistently relevant and up-to-date to meet the evolving needs and interests of the user base.



Ensuring the quality and accuracy of content on the platform to maintain user trust and engagement.



Securing consistent funding to sustain platform operations and development



Retaining user interest and engagement over the long term



Navigating and adapting to changing legal and regulatory landscapes, especially in terms of data privacy and content moderation



Building and sustaining an engaged user/contributor community.
