

Lesson Learned

Serving Priority Information Needs

Satisfying priority information needs requires many consultations, separating "needs" from "wants", and "personal" from "organizational" needs. Other platform developments e.g. C40, GPML are essential to consult

Content Production

Prioritizing content, maintaining responsive relationships with contributors, and documenting progress and challenges are crucial for maintaining effective content production.

Copyright and Access Rights

Determining copyright and access rights for content can be complicated and requires understanding and monitoring government legal regulations, conditions set by content providers and international standards.
