

# Wastewater Management Expert (WaMEX) Tool

### ADB's New Wastewater Management Expert System to Evaluate Technologies and Sewer Networks

The Asian Development Bank (ADB) and the UNESCO-IHE teamed up to develop the wastewater management expert system that will provide decision-makers and planners with a tool to carry out "what-if" scenarios to effectively evaluate technologies and sewer networks.

## Forging a Partnership to Develop a Decision Support System

In March 2009, during a high level sanitation dialogue between ADB and its DMC clients, several key areas have been identified that need greater focus: institutions and policies; technology options; financing options and private sector participation; information, education, and communication; and economics of sanitation. One of the key actions to respond to these focal points is to develop a decision support system – an Expert System – that will facilitate the evaluation of different sanitation options, selection of suitable and cost-effective technologies, and planning and design of environmental sanitation projects.

As one of the knowledge products, the Expert System – WaMEX – will assist decision-makers to evaluate wastewater management options, and thus enhance capabilities of those responsible in ensuring that sanitation services are effectively delivered.


#### What WaMEX Can Do

Day 1 (Tuesday) - 10 December

- Evaluates wastewater management system options based on effluent and influent characteristics, water quality standards to be achieved, technology efficiency criteria, and costs.
- Shows investment efficiency of technology options based on preliminary cost estimates of wastewater treatment technologies, pollution removal efficiency, and cost per removal.
- Provides mapping tool and cost estimates for sewer system options.
- Supports assessment and implementation of a sanitation roadmap, including appropriate treatment technologies, sewer network, financing or ways of scaling up to meet sanitation targets.
