Indonesia's ambitious economic growth aspirations are dependent, among other things, on its ability to expand access to reliable and clean sources of energy, for all its citizens. The government initiated a series of sector reforms in 2013-2014 and is seeking to accelerate them during 2015-2019 with the aim to (i) expand energy production through greater private sector investment and more effective public sector investment; (ii) bolster the sustainability of the energy sector through increased reliance on domestic gas, renewable energy, and energy efficiency investments; and (iii) provide access to modern energy to all Indonesians.

The Centre of Excellence on Clean Energy (Centre), to be established by the Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources (MEMR), is envisioned to help push this agenda forward. As designed, the Centre will facilitate integration of clean energy knowledge drawn from national and international expertise and assist in the deployment of clean energy technology solutions from public and private sector entities.

Objectives

This Knowledge Partnership Dialogue will explore common goals with development partners and public and private entities, and scope collaborative opportunities in the deployment of clean energy. The focus of these discussions will concern the Indonesian Government's Centre of Excellence, its proposed operations and facilities, and its role in supporting the needs of the energy sector for investment in, and implementation of, clean-energy initiatives.

Expected Outputs

At the end of the 2-day dialogue, the MEMR should have enriched the concept, objectives and development strategies of the Centre with inputs from government entities, development partners, and the private sector. Possibilities for collaboration and investments in the key priorities for clean energy in Indonesia should also have been explored.
