While the 1997/98 Asian financial crisis was a watershed moment for many Asian economies' financial systems, the economic impacts of elevated NPL levels persisted well beyond the crisis period. The euro area's more recent experience also illustrates the systemic and negative impact large NPLs can have on all economies in a region. Against this background, this workshop will examine the macrofinancial implications of NPLs, highlight country case studies, and discuss policy lessons for the development of NPL resolution strategies in Asia and Europe.
