Achieving SDG target 6.2 of universal access to adequate and equitable sanitation requires faecal waste to be safely contained, transported, and treated along the sanitation service chain.

While there are multiple technology options for achieving the SDG target, choices at the point of containment critically affect subsequent transport and treatment choices. Sanitary behavior change at the point of faecal containment is complicated because it lies within the remit of residential and commercial premises rather than public service providers.

Join us to explore on-site sanitary behavior change in the Pacific. The webinar will cover the principles of sanitary decision-making under development by the ADB for the Good Enough Guide to On-site Sanitation in the Pacific.
