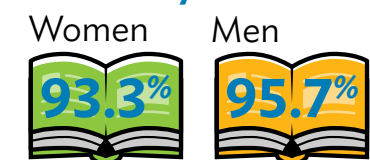

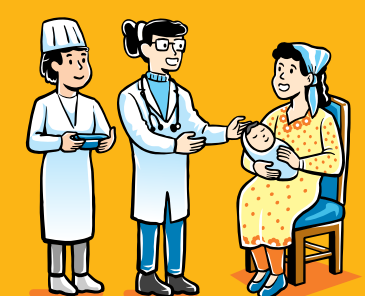

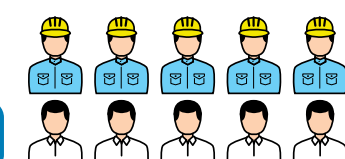
Female Labor Participation Rate

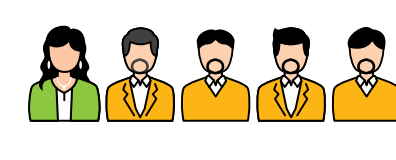
Male Labor Participation Rate

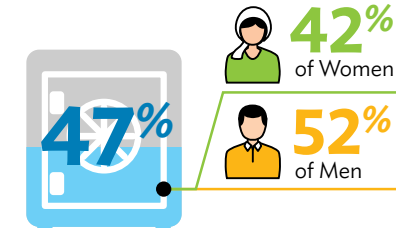

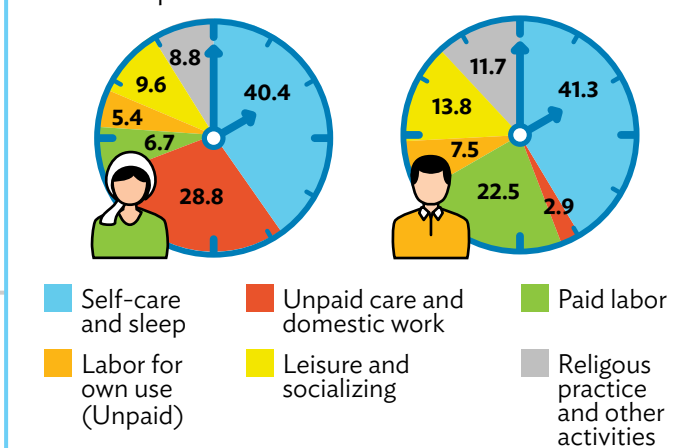


Adults who have bank accounts



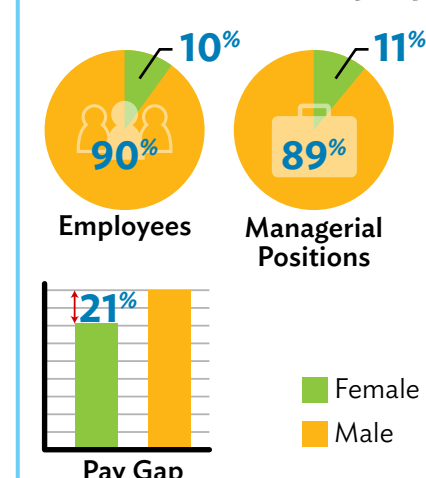
PAID AND UNPAID WORK

*Rural Population



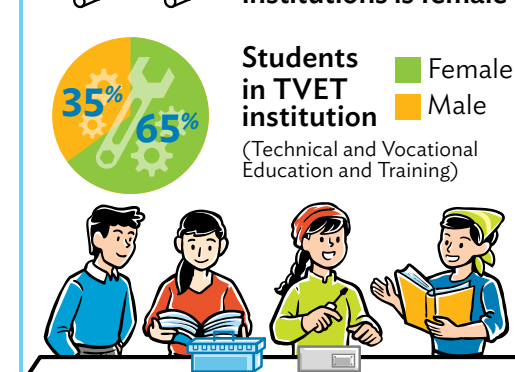

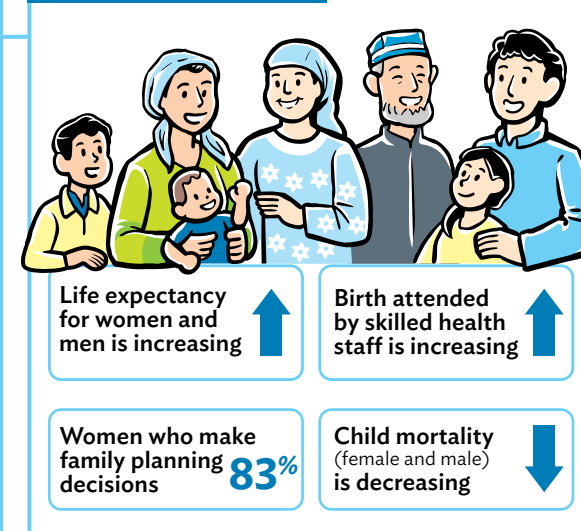

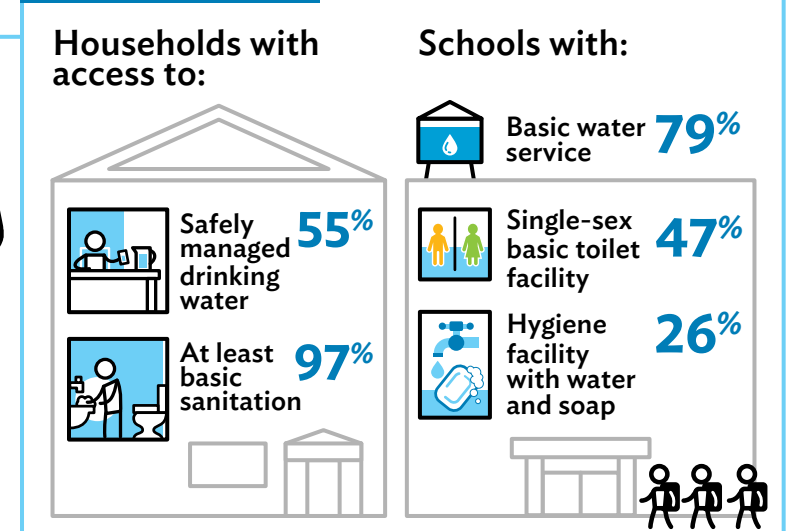

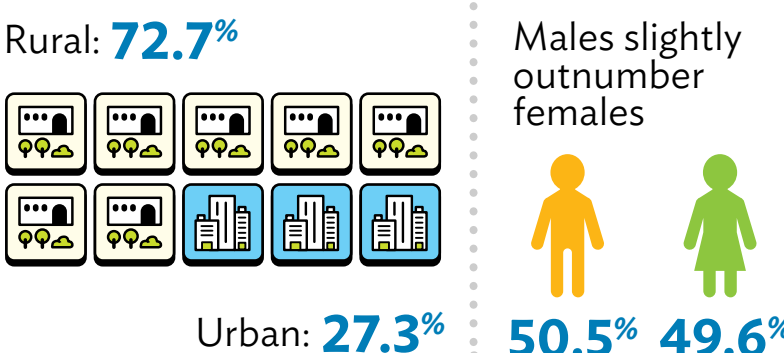

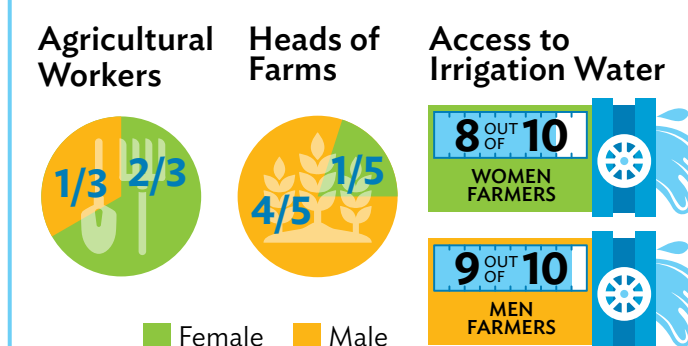

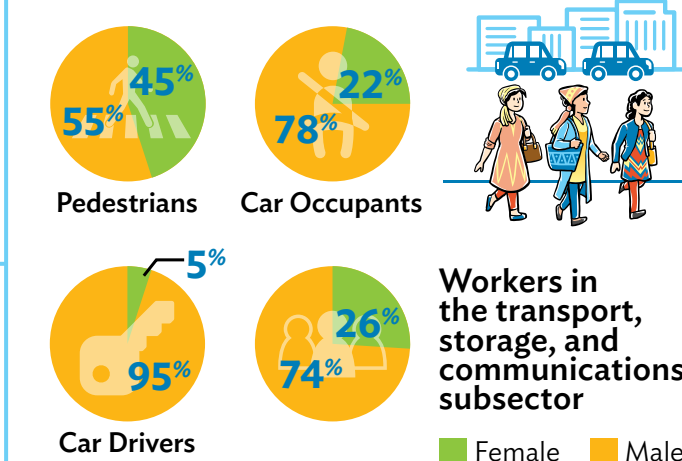

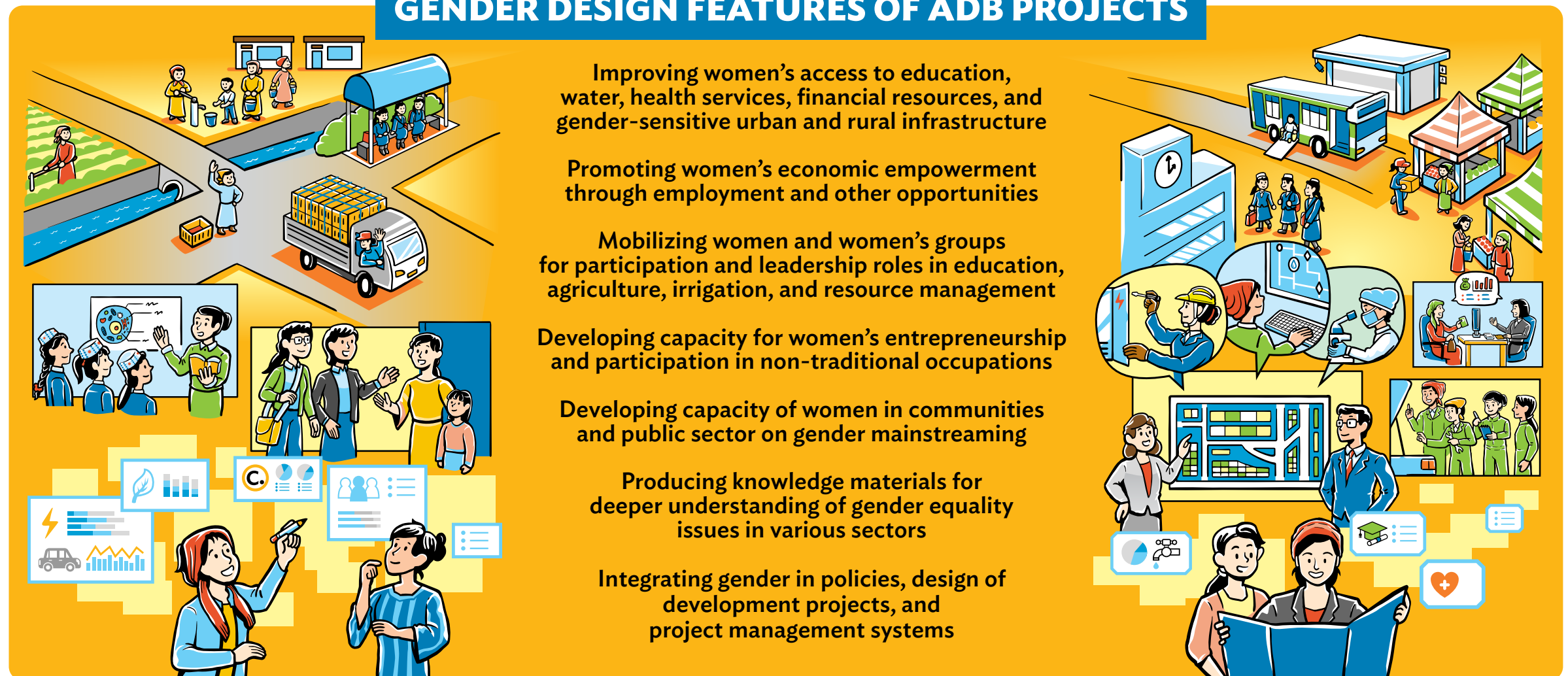
