Background

Bangladesh Resident Mission (BRM) of the Asian Development Bank (ADB) organizes Business Opportunities Seminar (BOS) annually as its flagship event to attract quality suppliers, contractors, and consultants from Bangladesh and abroad in ADB funded projects. BOS apprises the business opportunities available in ADB funded projects in Bangladesh. Currently, the uncontracted amount under ADB funded projects in the country is about \$2.9 billion.
