- Water District Development Sector Project
 - Sector loan \$50 million, 2011 approval
 - Small and medium sized water utilities
- Urban Water Supply and Sanitation Investment Program
 - Multitranche financing facility (MFF) \$200 million, 2012 approval
 - Metro Cebu and Davao City
 - Opportunities for PPP



INDONESIA

- Metropolitan Sanitation Management & Health Project:
 - Wastewater Medan & Yogyakarta
