1ST MISSION

- To train highly skilled labour to provide sufficient quantity and adequate vocational structure and level to ensure the quality for economic sector and regions, especially key areas

- Conduct assessment and issue national vocational certificates at different levels for workers in various socio-economic sectors

- Vocational college:230

Vocational trained labour: 34.4mil including 8 mil labour at vocational college and secondary level

Vocational teachers: 77.000 (59.000 teaching in vocational college and secondary schools)

By 2020: 100% of vocational college and secondary schools are/pass the accreditation)

Build 400 sets of national skill standards
