- 3. Nutrition security at risk




1. High and Volatile Food Prices



- 44 million fell into poverty due to the food price rise from mid-2010 to early 2011.
- Fiscal policy responses of DMCs to food inflation entail substantial fiscal burdens.


2. Vulnerable food system



- Food productivity must be doubled to feed 9 billion in 2050 (3 billion more middle income consumers in 2030):
 - resources scarcity and competing demands among food, feed, energy concerns (Land and water)
 - O adverse climate change impacts: 20-30% crop output reduction expected in 9 DMCs
 - Sustainable Transformational productivity improvement

3. High prevalence of hunger and malnutrition

Undernourishment In 2010 By Region (Millions)




- •Asia and Pacific region: home to 2/3 of the undernourished in the world.
- •Human capital of next generation in developing Asia is at risk: almost half of children under 5 is stunted in South Asia.




Operational Plan for Sustainable Food Security

- \$2 billion annually




FS Investments 2009-11 Sectoral distribution
