Development Context: HD at Crossroads

- High economic growth and several countries moving to middle income bracket
 - transformation in the economic structure and rapid urbanization
 - huge infrastructure demand
 - rapidly changing demand patterns for education, health and social protection
- Mixed progress in HD and widening inequality
 - partly due to underinvestment in the social sectors
- Demographic dividend for the next two decades before population starts aging fast
 - S. Asia is now a major supplier of labor despite low skills
- Globalization: increased inter and intra-regional dependence
- Knowledge, innovation and technology as key driver for sustaining growth
- Emergence of private sector
 - eroding quality of social services and flights to quality
