
## Transport in the Asia and Pacific region

## Air quality and transport



Congestion

Road congestion diminishes regional GDP by 2-5% each year in Asia and the Pacific

Roadway capacity additions have not proven to be an effective way to reduce congestion



### **Road accidents**

Economies of Asia and Pacific lose approximately \$96 billion per year in income due to road accidents

Over 50% of the victims of road accidents in Asia and the Pacific are vulnerable road users (e.g. pedestrians)






