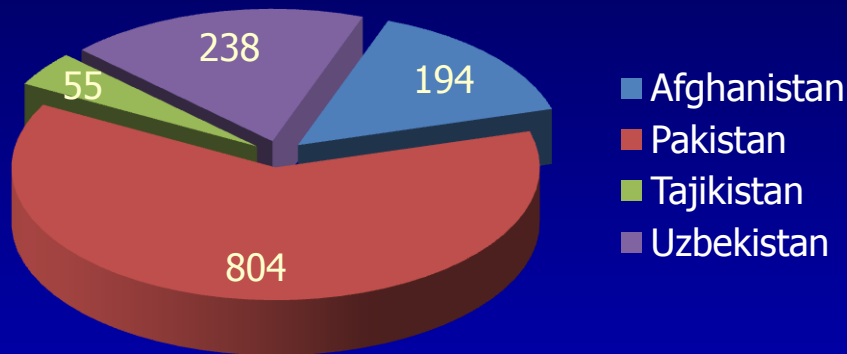

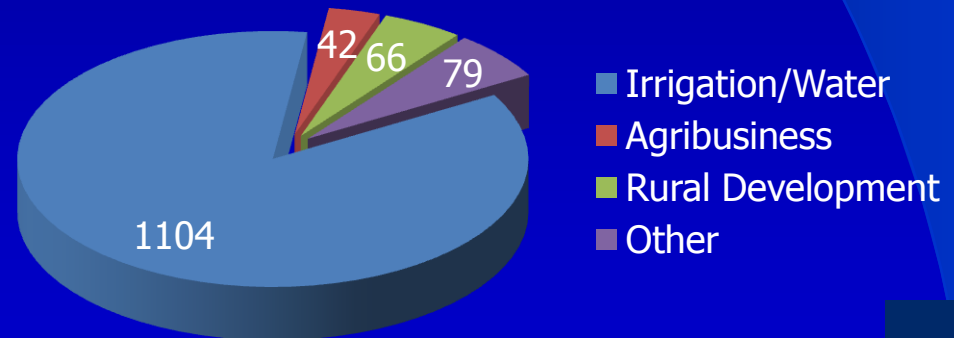

\$1,291 million - 2012



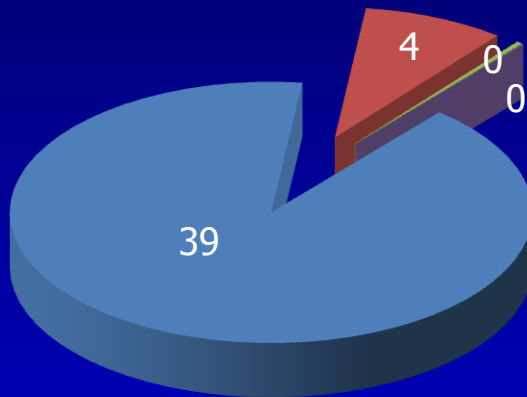

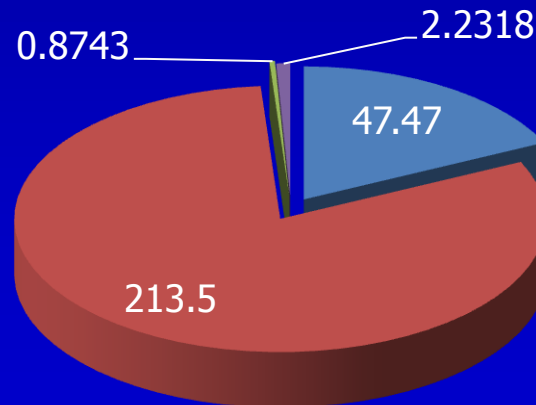

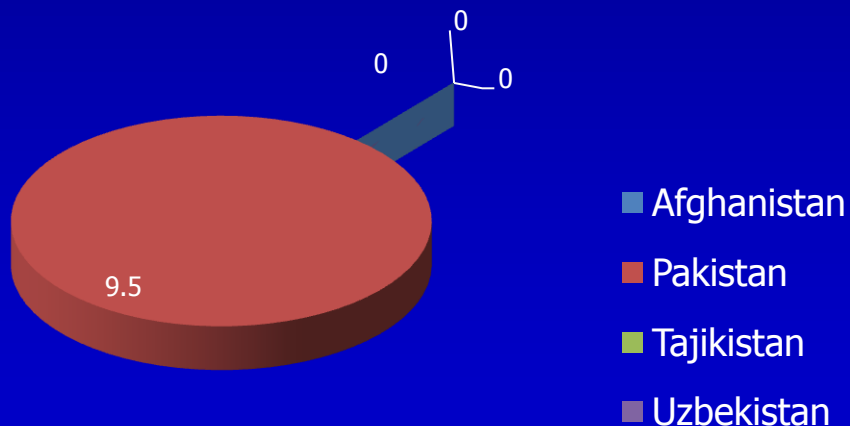

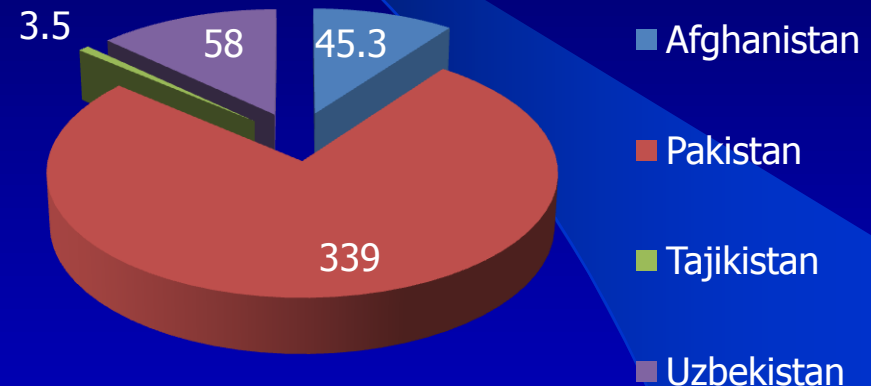


Ongoing Loan/Grant Portfolio

Anticipated Consulting Services Contracts for 2012 \$9.5 million

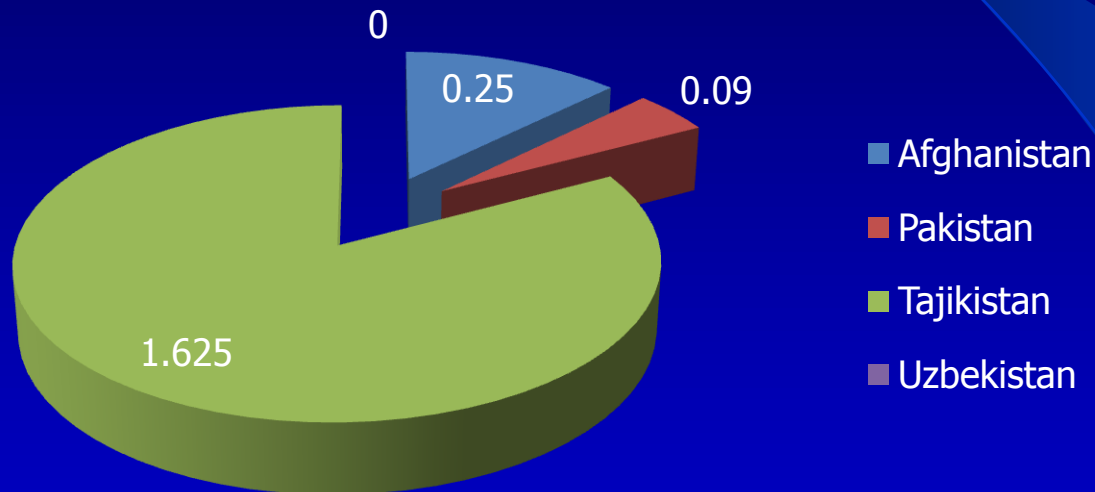


Anticipated ICB Civil Works Contracts for 2012 \$446 million



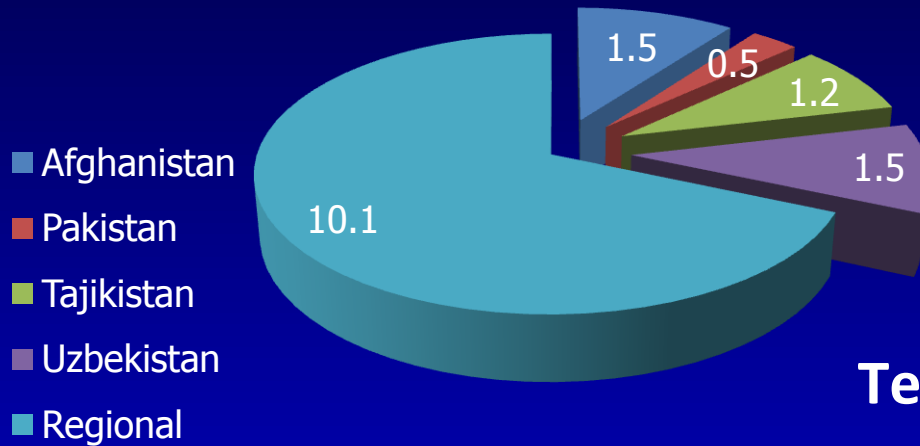

Anticipated Equipment Contracts for 2012 \$ 2 million



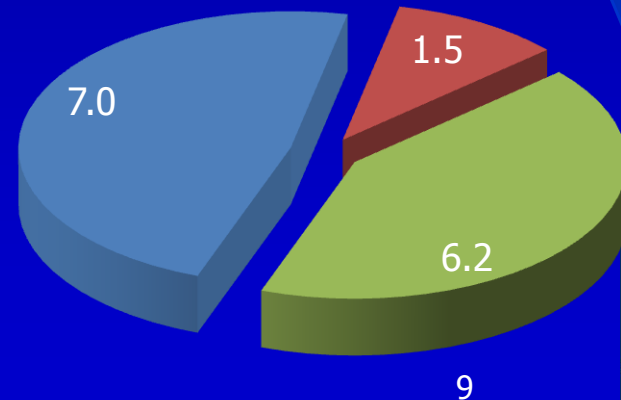

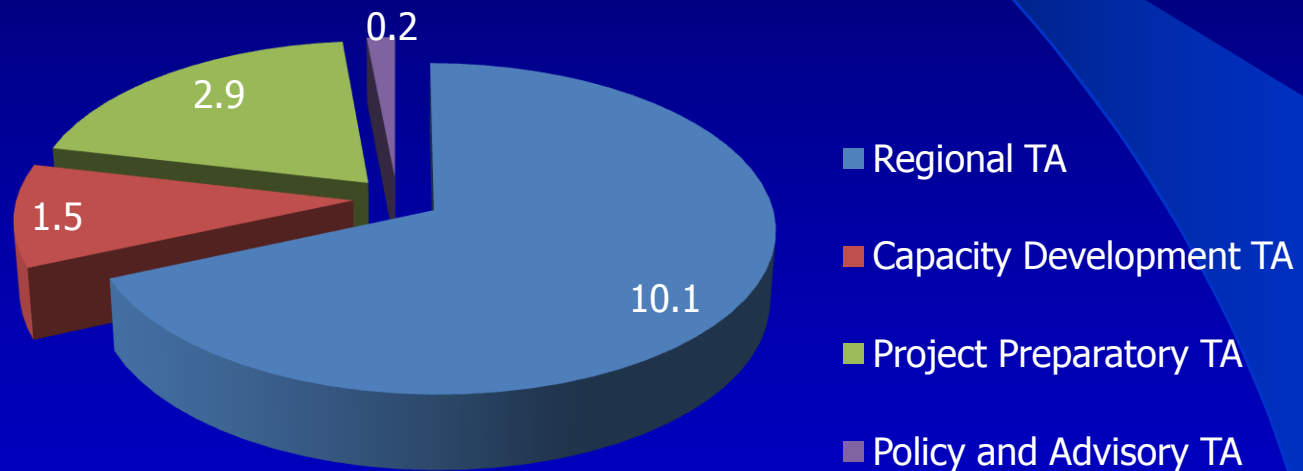

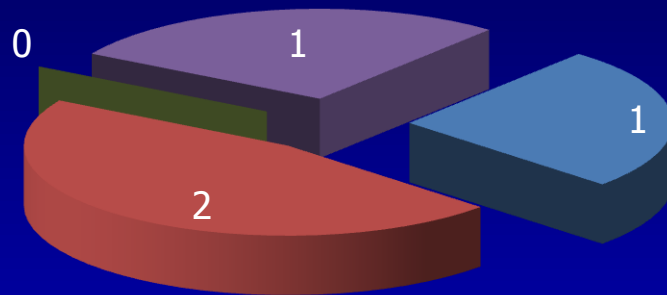

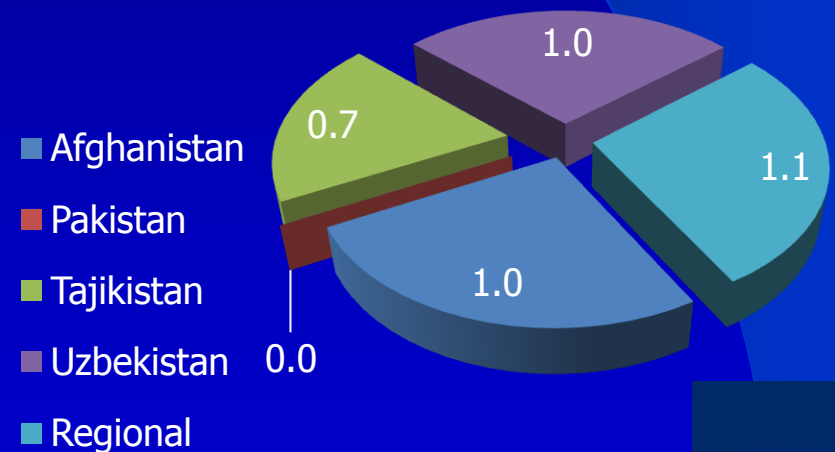

Anticipated Consulting Services Contracts for 2012 \$4 million



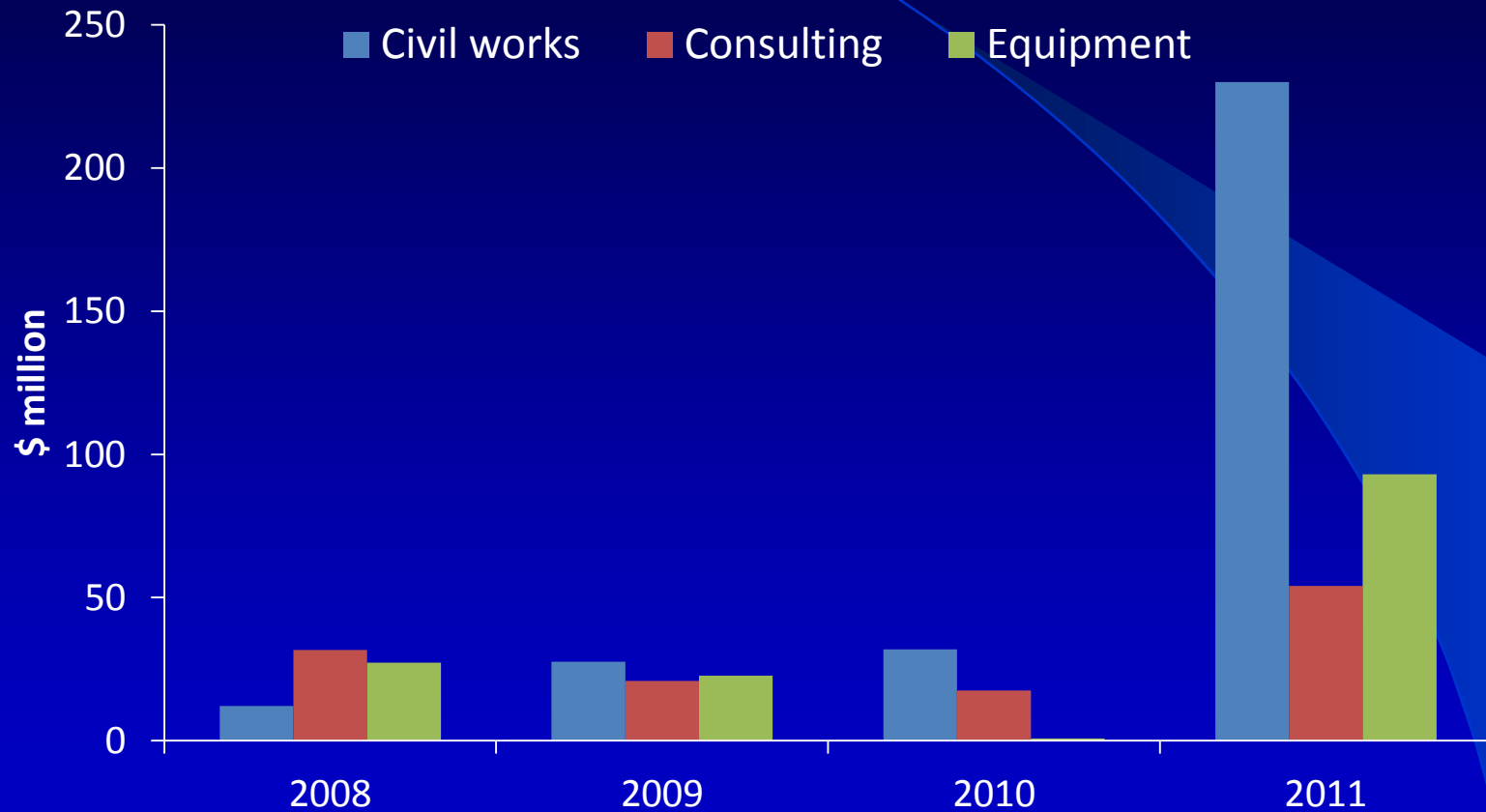

2013

- AFG: Water Resources Development MFF Subsequent Tranches - \$216 million
- UZB: Amu Bukhara Irrigation - \$300 million
- TAJ: Building Climate Resilience in Pyanj River Basin - \$14.6 million
