Country Partnership Strategy

- **Road network** rehabilitation, rural roads, more effective road maintenance systems, and road safety
- Efficient and safe **railways** with strong regional dimensions and facilitation of containerization
- **Urban transport**, non-motorized transport, multimodal passenger hubs, and traffic demand management
- **Inland waterways** and inland ports
- **Multimodal logistics** centers, logistics services, and intelligent transport systems
- Key **policy reforms** including asset management and road maintenance, efficiency and safety of transport services, and effective urban transport planning

Transport Sector Strategy in Mongolia

Country Partnership Strategy

- **Regional and international transport corridors** to reduce transport and logistics costs for trade and foster regional cooperation
