

My Life Saving Rules

Heights

I will always use fall prevention techniques where there is a risk of falling

Contractors

I will validate and ensure contractors uphold the same standards for health and safety

Asbestos

I can only work with asbestos under approved and exceptional circumstances

Emergency Response

I will always know and understand what I need to do in the event of an emergency

Safety Conversations

I talk about safety and Zero Harm at work and at home

Vehicles

I know my vehicle is safe to drive and I will drive defensively

Risk Assessment and Job Planning

I know what can go wrong on every job and have done what I need to do to stop it happening

Tools and Equipment

I will only use the correct tools for the job and will inspect them to ensure they are safe to use

Isolation

Before starting work I will ensure all energy sources have been isolated and de-energised

Housekeeping

I will ensure that good housekeeping practices are maintained to minimize the risk of injury. "A place for everything and everything in its place"

Manual Handling

I will assess manual handling risks and where possible use mechanical aids or seek assistance prior to performing manual handling tasks

HSE Reviews

I participate in regular HSE review meetings (e.g. Tool Box Talks, Pre-Start meetings, HSE committee meetings)

Training and Competency

I commit to not operating equipment I am not trained for and will speak up if requested to perform a task I am not competent to do.

Site Rules

- ✦ SMOKING is FORBIDDEN anywhere onsite, including admin building, stores, car park, yard, vehicles
- ✦ Speed Limit 10 kph
- ✦ Vehicles have right of way, except at pedestrian crossings
- ✦ Minimum PPE requirements apply
- ✦ All safety signs must be obeyed
- ✦ Pedestrian access via marked walkways only
- ✦ All employees and contractors **MUST** be inducted to access the site
- ✦ All visitors **MUST** sign in and be escorted at all times by inducted personnel
- ✦ All hazards, incidents and near misses **MUST** be reported
