#### **Content of the Summary Assessment**

- Integrated assessment of strengths & weaknesses in PFM system performance within each of the six PFM dimensions
- Impact of PFM weaknesses on government's ability to achieve the main budgetary outcomes
- Prospects for reform planning & implementation
- Other country-specific purposes as required by ToR
- The main message



#### **Dimensions of PFM performance**

- Credibility of the budget (PI-1 to 4)
- Comprehensiveness and transparency (PI-5 to 10)
- Policy-based budgeting (PI-11 & 12)
- Predictability & control in budget execution (PI-13:21)
- Accounting, recording & reporting (PI-22 to 25)
- External scrutiny & audit (PI-26 to 28)

**ALSO**: D-1 to 3 impact of donor practices on PFM performance in aid-dependent countries



# Impact of PFM Weaknesses on Budgetary Outcomes

- Fiscal discipline
- Strategic allocation of resources
- Efficient delivery of services

The PFM-PR does not necessarily explain if these outcomes are being met: Other inputs required for this analysis. The PFM-PR should explain if PFM system provides government with functioning tools to achieve these 3 outcomes



# Prospects for Reform Planning and Implementation

- Machinery for PFM reform planning & monitoring, & factors affecting its working
- Links to other public sector reforms & interdependencies



### **The Story Line**

- What is the story line, the number one message?
- Make sure the story gets top billing it may be all that readers remember!
- It is also the likely starting point for discussion of PFM reform priorities



### Indicator relevance to budgetary outcomes – possible answers

Aggregate fiscal discipline: e.g.?

Strategic allocation of resources: e.g.?

Efficient use of resources in service delivery: e.g.?

**All** are influenced by integrity of fiscal information
