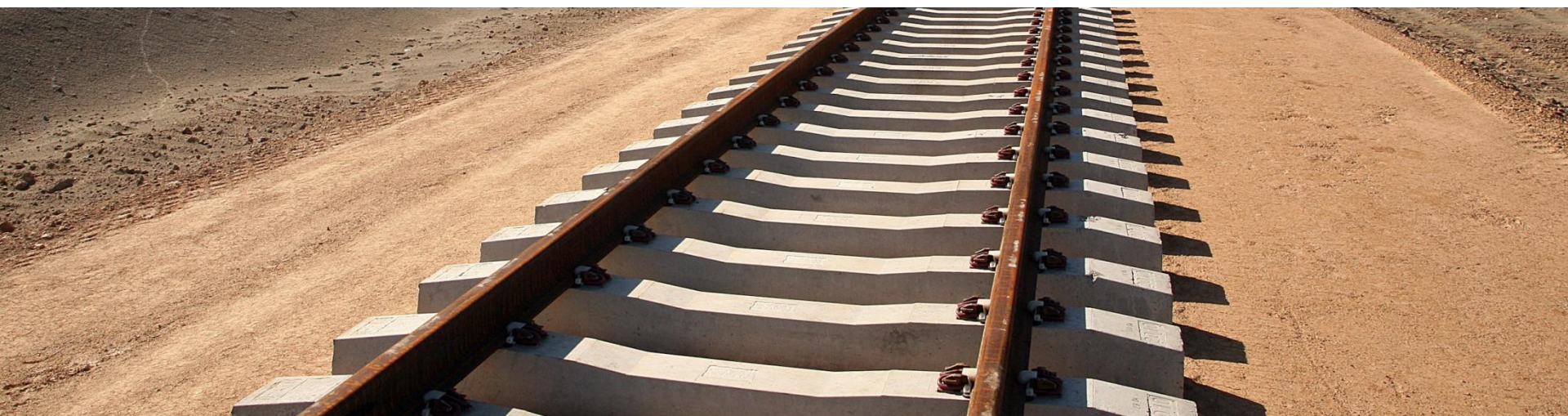

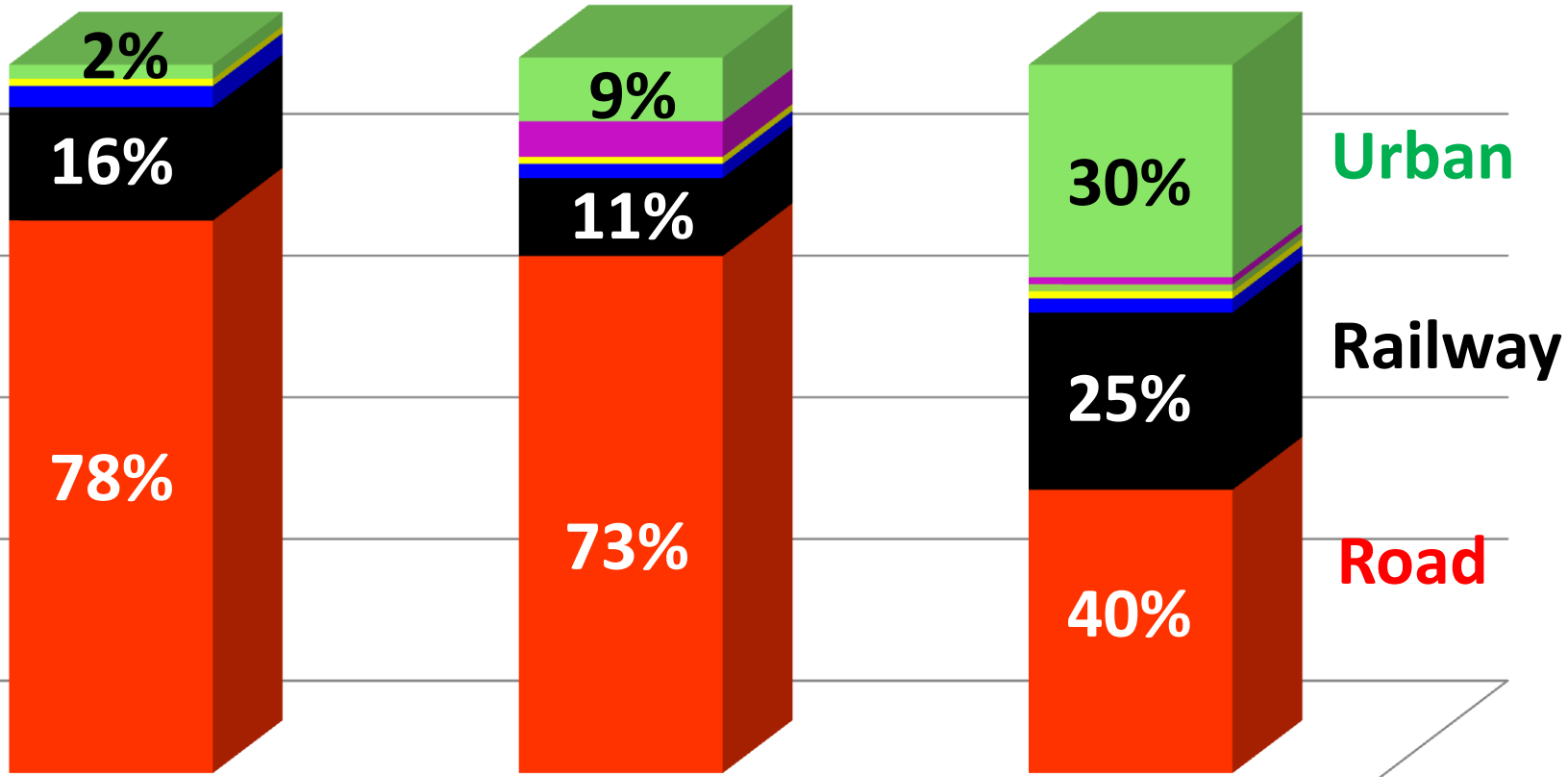

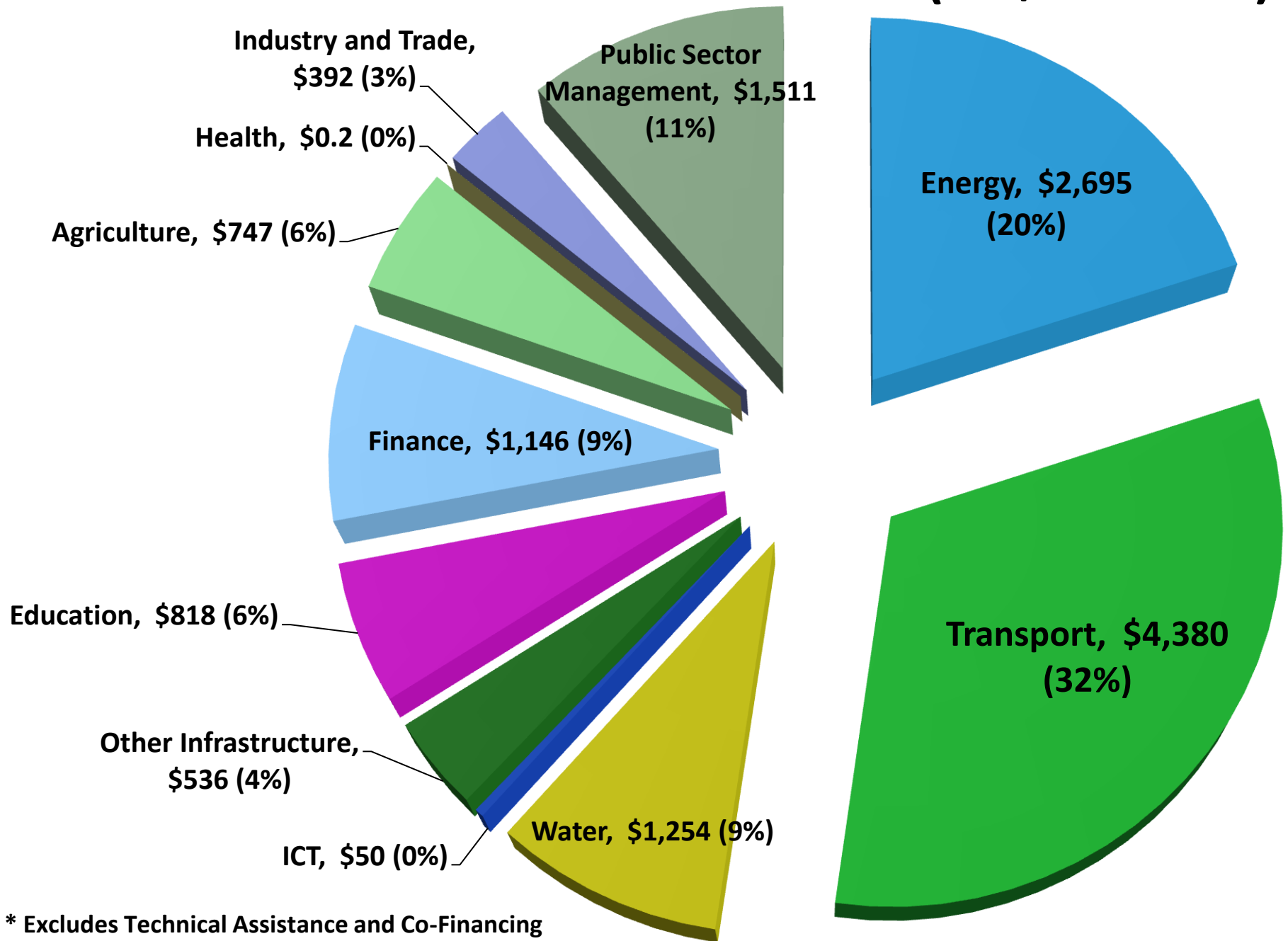

Total ADB Loans and Grants 2014* (US\$ millions)

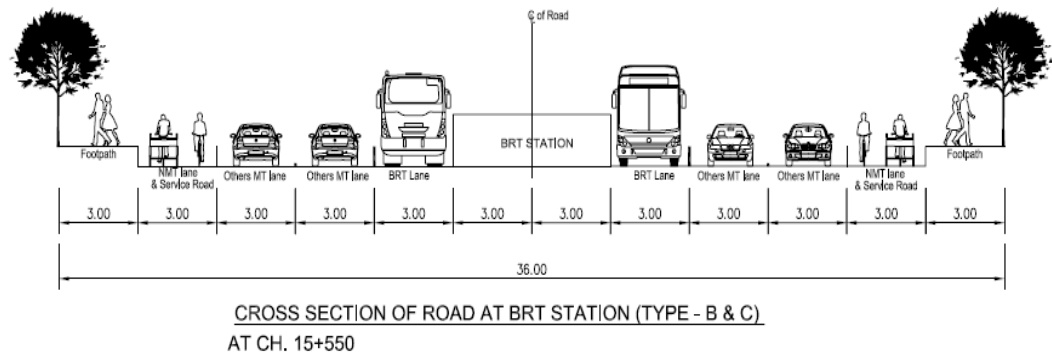


ADB transport: 2014 in numbers

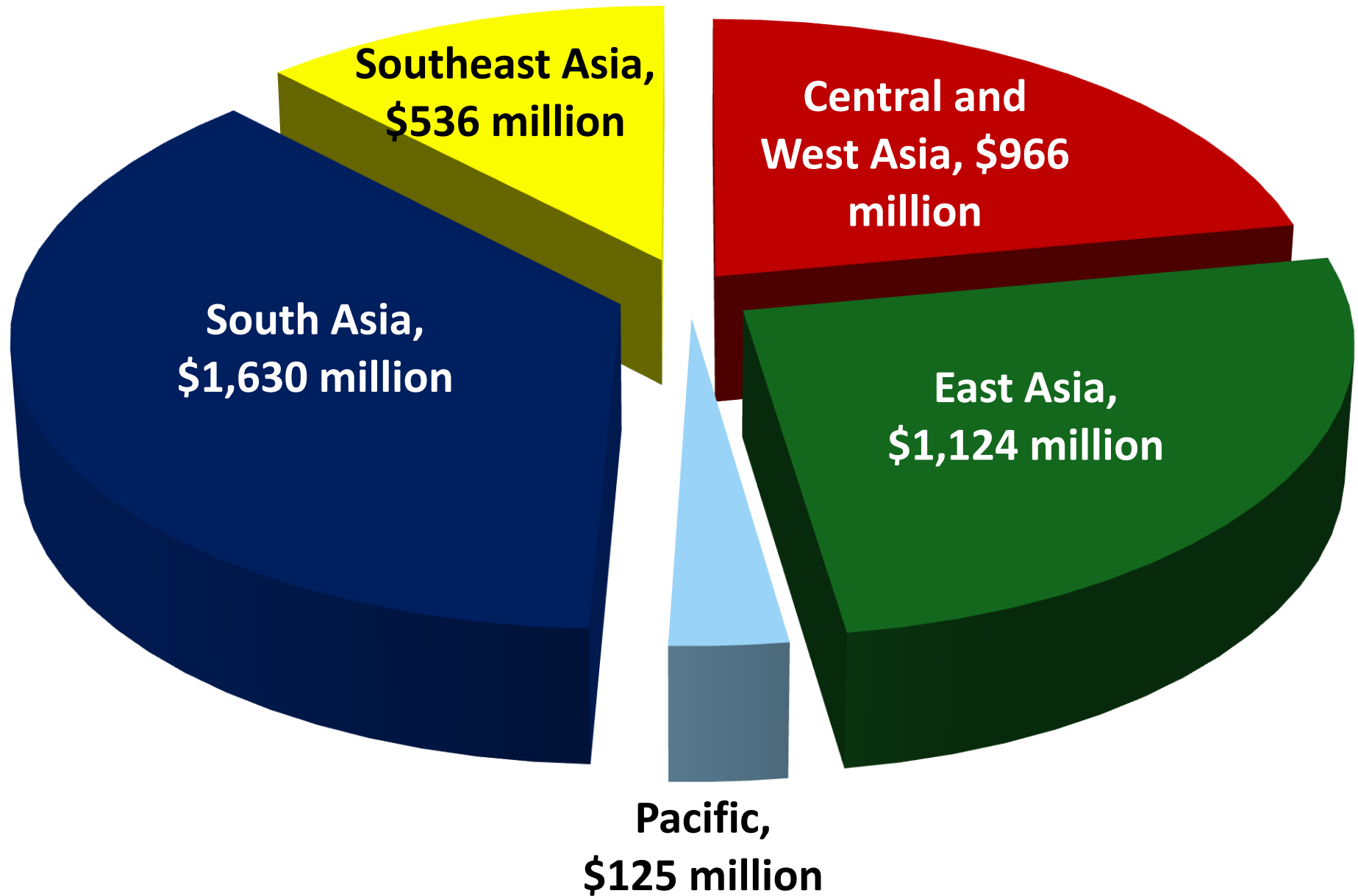
Total of **52** loans and grants and **40** technical assistance projects approved

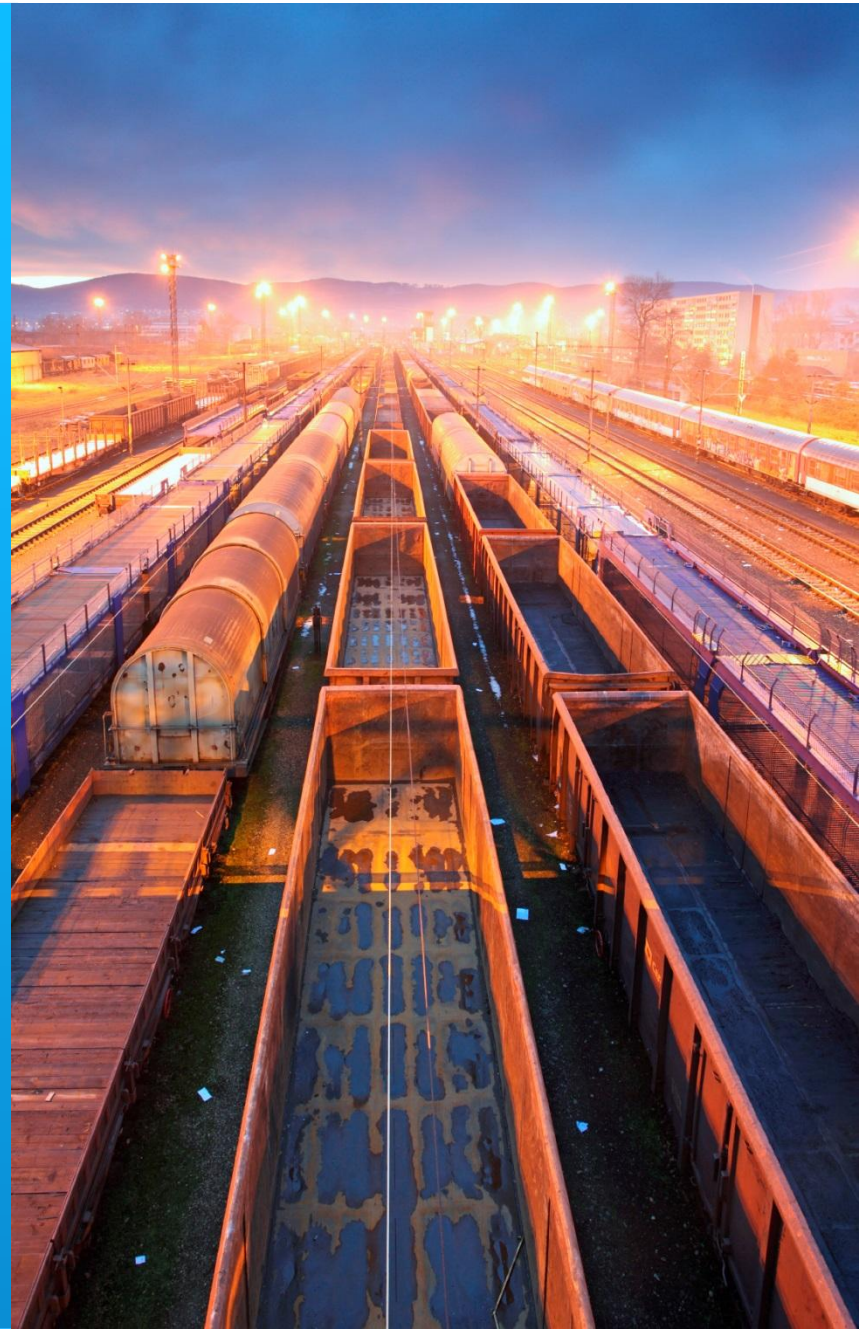
