


Indonesia at a Glance





SPENDING RATIO











FACTS on GOVERNMENT PROCUREMENT







1. Inefficiency of State Budget Management

The government estimates that certain amount of state budget lost every year about 20% – 30% due to inefficiency associated with the procurement processes.

2. Corruption Cases

Corruption Eradication Commission (KPK) stated 80% of all corruption cases are associated with misused of public procurement.

3. International and National Competitiveness

- Lack of capacity and opportunity to participate in nasional economy (small and medium enterprises).
- Lack of capacity and opportunity to participate in international market.

4. High Cost Economy

Lack of competitiveness due to market asymetric information and closed market.

4 Pillars of Public Procurement Reform

- 1. Regulatory Framework
- 2. Institutional Development
- 3. Procurement Operations & Market
- 4. Integrity & Transparency





E-Procurement Business Model Implementation

- Procurement functions decentralized throughout procurement unit/tender committee from all procuring entities.
- e-Procurement is implemented electronically through decentralized e-Procurement system known as SPSE that operated by e-Procurement Service Unit called LPSE.
- Provincial, City and District have obligation to establish LPSE.
- By 2013, procuring entities should spend 100% of budget using e-Proc
- Success to establish 627 e-Procurement Service Unit (LPSE) as single e-market place (54 Ministiries/Agencies, 33 Provincial, 483 City/District, 4 State-Owned Enterprise, 53 Other Institution).
- Success to establish 527 procurement unit (ULP).





System Interconection






E-Procurement System Aplication Development

- SPSE Core System is developed inhoused/internally by SPSE Development Team NPPA
- SPSE is developed as open source, free license, and full support application which is being implemented in all LPSE.
- **SPSE** has dynamic versioning method, last version is SPSE 4.0. SPSE is developed collaboratively with universities, communities, and other agencies, i.e:
 - 1. encryption document with National Security Agency
 - 2. e-Procurement AuditTrail with BPKP (Finance and Development Supervisory Agency)





E-Procurement Service Implementation Model



Infrastructure Topology













Amount of Tender Ceiling (US\$ million)
