




NUMBER OF BID AND AWARD NOTICES COMPARISON

Government Owned - the initial investment and recurrent operation costs are financed from the government budget

Public-Private Partnership - a private firm providing e-GP application services for the government. Users pay for the service.

II. PHILGEPS BUSINESS MODEL

Government Managed Service

Funding	Funded by the Government. Implemented fees for system cost recovery 2 nd quarter of 2013
System Delivery	Service contract with 3 rd party service provider for provision of system, infrastructure, disaster recovery plan with backup site, development and support services for fixed monthly service fee.
Cost to Government	P50M a year for all system delivery services and functions. Government operates and funds the PhilGEPS support office.
Time/Cost to implement	Pilot system – implementation 6 months; 5 year operation - \$200,000 funded by CIDA Current PhilGEPS system development – 18 months implementation.
Resources supporting operations	PhilGEPS office has 36 personnel. Service Provider has 13 personnel

The focus of the Open Data Philippines initiative is to consolidate government data (such as budget, procurement, health, education, etc.) into one searchable website, where data will not only be downloadable in spreadsheet formats but will also be presented thru visually-engaging graphics, dashboards, and other forms of applications.




