

Stages of development of e-GP in Kyrgyz Republic



Background of the Project III – version of e-Procurement system

- Starting from 2012, the Kyrgyz Republic Government prioritizes the public procurement reforms as the key political initiative. To develop solid electronic public procurement system the Government requested technical assistance from ADB in 2012 to develop and implement E-Procurement system.
- In December 2012, ADB accorded approval vide Project Number 46397 001 under Capacity Development Technical Assistance (CDTA) to Kyrgyz Republic for implementation of e-Procurement System. This TA for implementation for e-Procurement is provided based on the ground work done during Feb 2012 May 2012 for preparation of e-GP Strategy for Kyrgyz Republic under "TA 7437 (REG): Asia Pacific Procurement Partnership Initiative, Contract Number S75200".
- Also for this Project involved International Consultant by the ADB to review and monitor implementation of the Technical Assistance (TA) provided by ADB for implementation of e-Procurement in Kyrgyz Republic.




Background of the Project


E-Procurement Project Implementation Structure




Status of development in implementation

- In June 2014, the new E-Procurement system was developed and an official opening of electronic Portal was held with participation of the Kyrgyz Republic Prime-Minister.
- Effective from 14 May 2015, all public procuring entities manage all kind of bids (goods, works and services) in the new E-Procurement Portal electronically that goes in accordance with the new Law on Public Procurement. Bid procedures in the Portal are transparent, effective and complete in terms of competition.



The number of trained specialists on the Portal since June 2014






Statistical data of the e-Procurement Portal

Positive sides:


- Support from the Government Office, which had issued instructions to all organizations;
- Massive training for all users;
- Help of civil society;
- The new law on public procurement (valid from May 16, 2015).

The difficulties of transition:

- Reluctance to move to e-procurement buyers;
- Temporary disruptions of the Portal;
- Low level of knowledge of buyers and suppliers (procurement procedures and computer skills / Internet).



The number of registered users on Portal






