- GIC-1999- three strategic programs
- Law on Information Transparency and Access to Information- June 16, 2011
- 7 years of advocacy and lobbying
- 2002: Mongolia in Transition: Legal analysis of the Mongolian legislation affecting freedoms of expression and information
- A Key problem- lack of the government transparency
- Mid-term strategy for 2002-2004
- New Strategic program :“The Right to Know: Freedom of Information.”
- Goal to lobby the RTI law

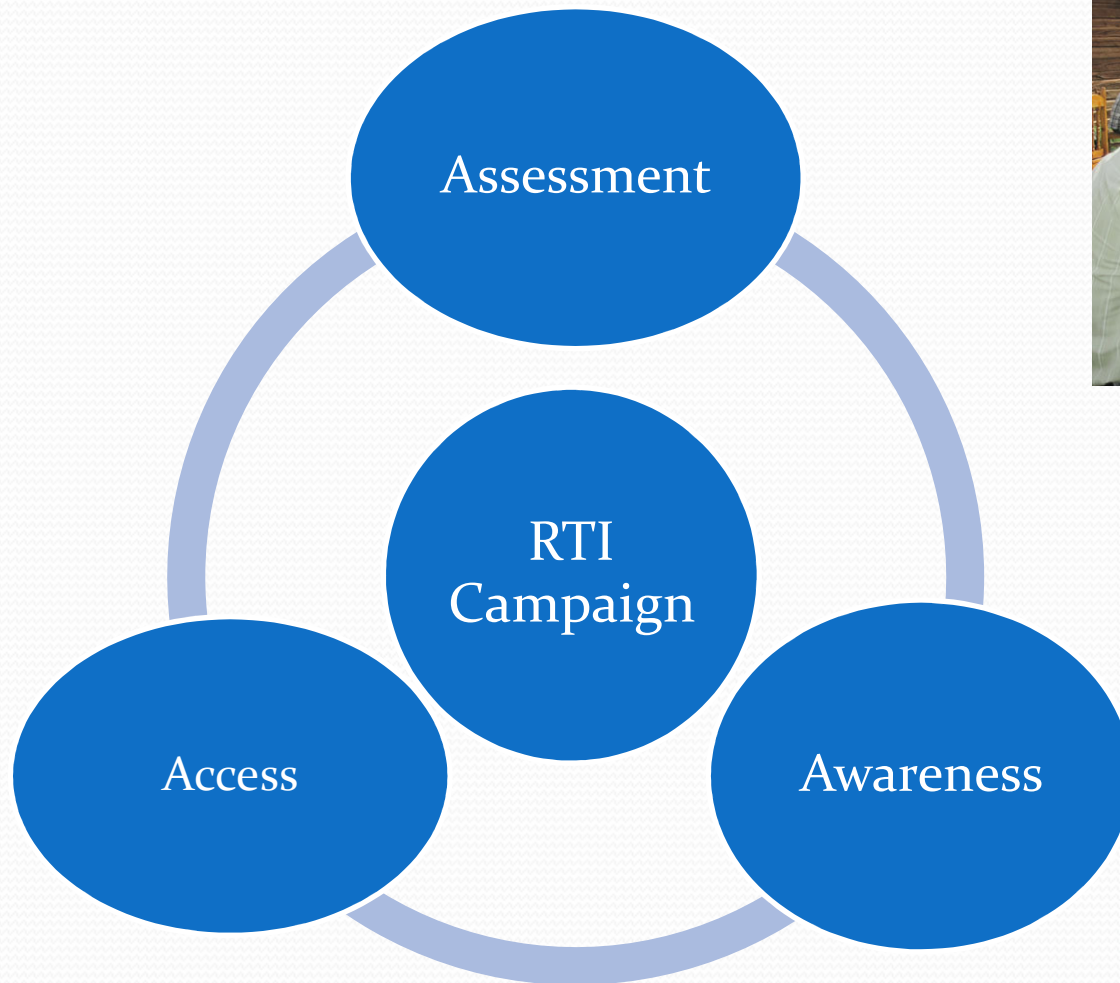

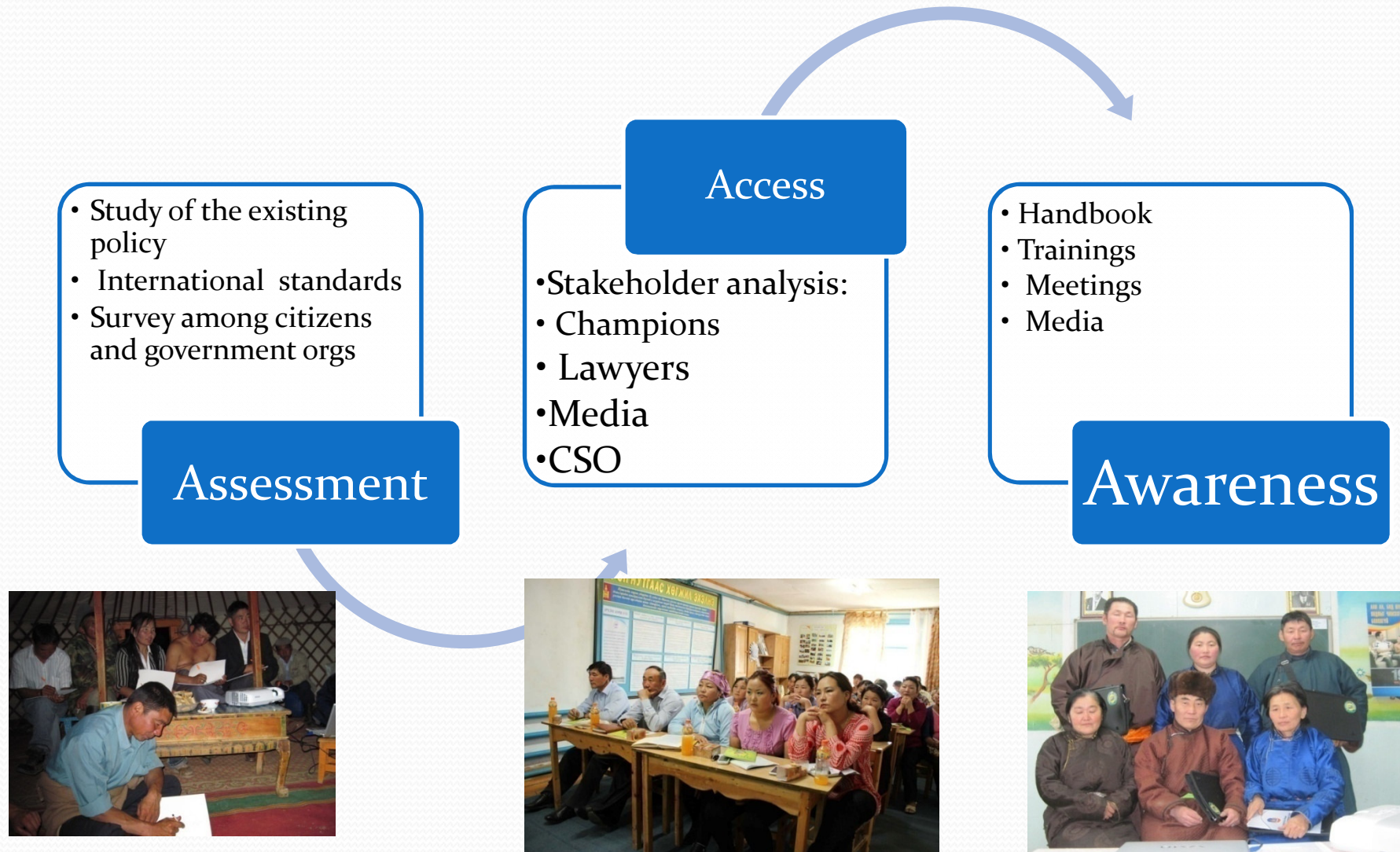

### Awareness:

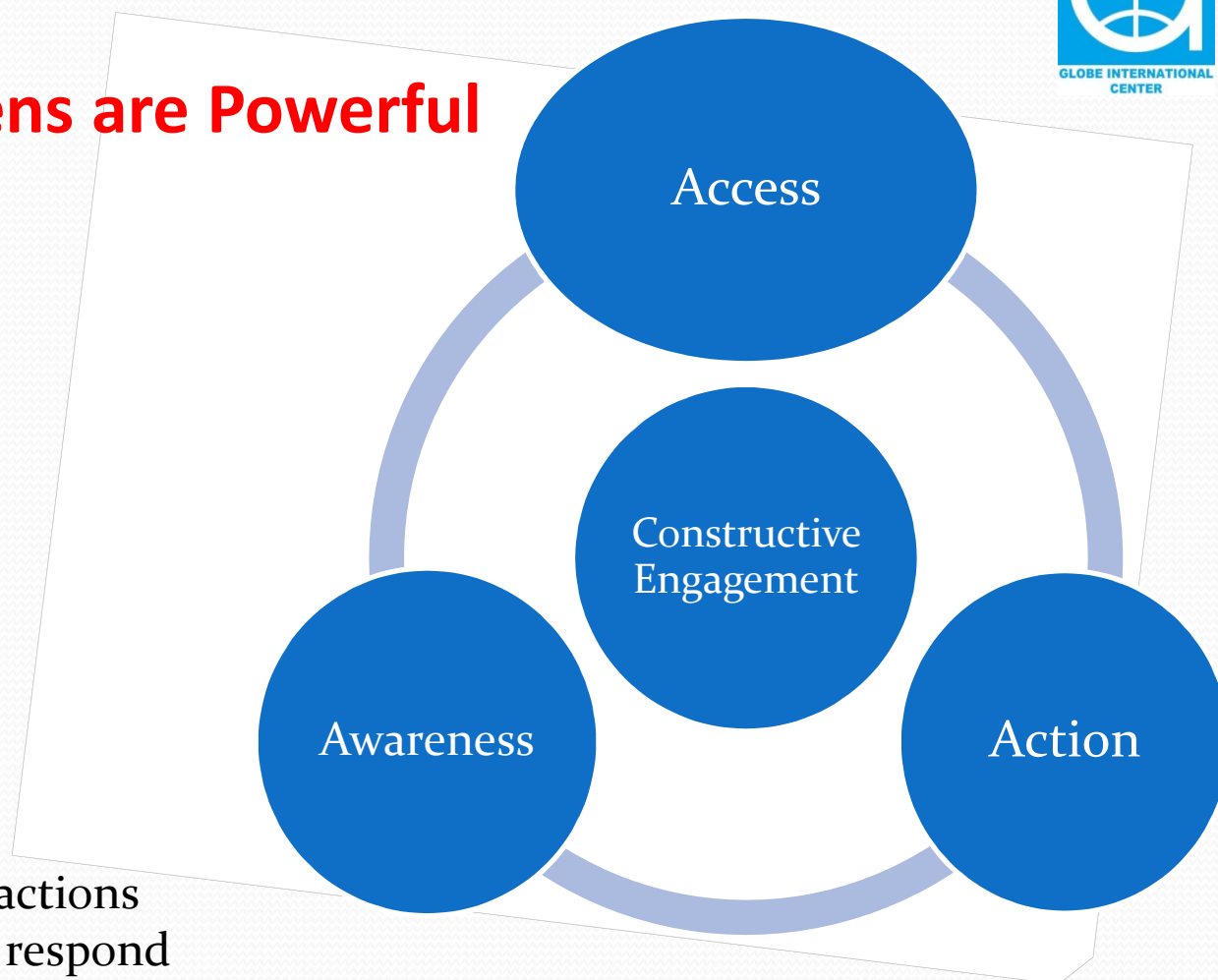
- Legal environment

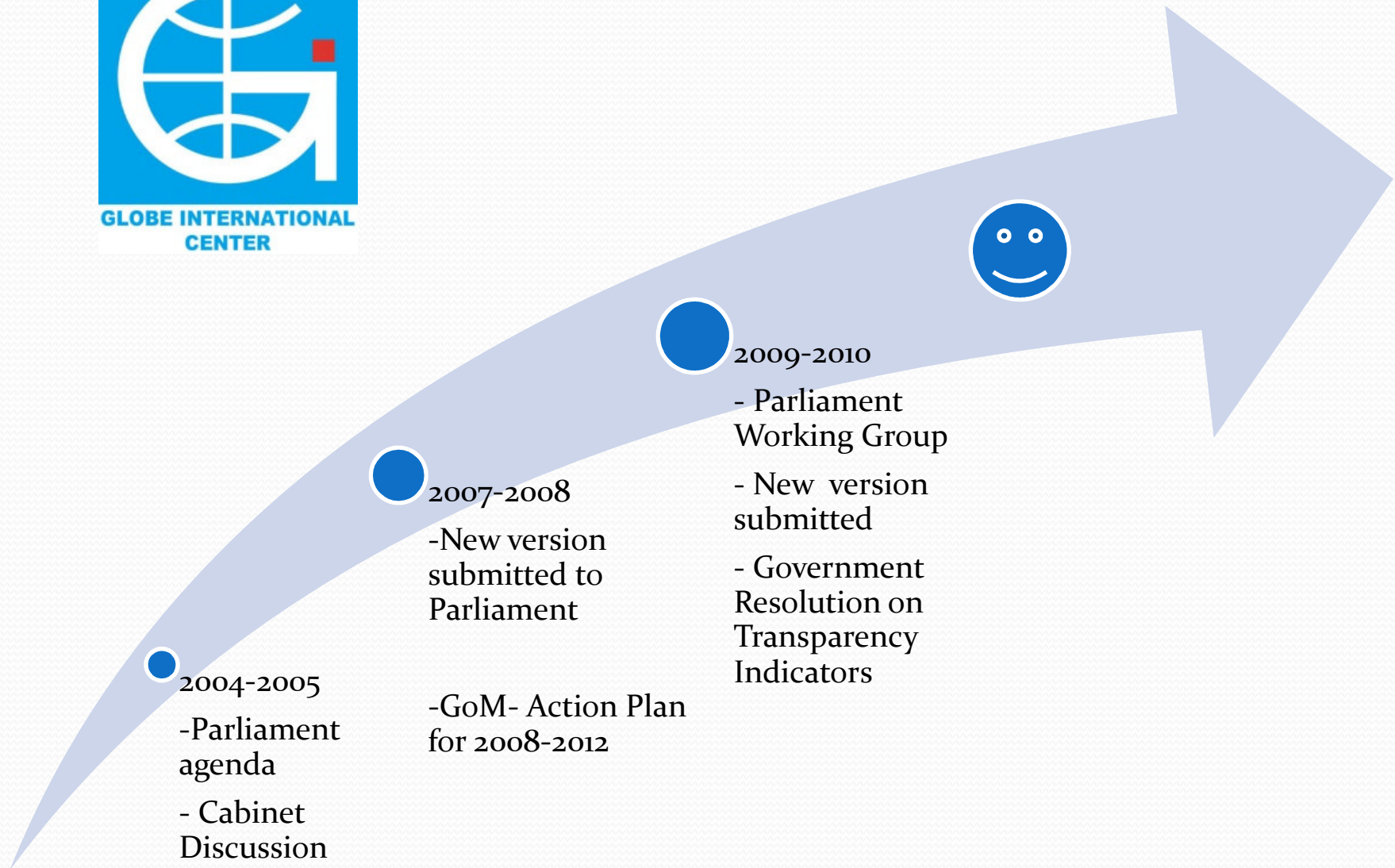
