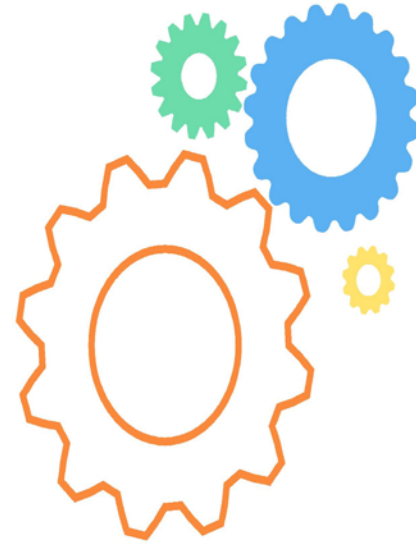

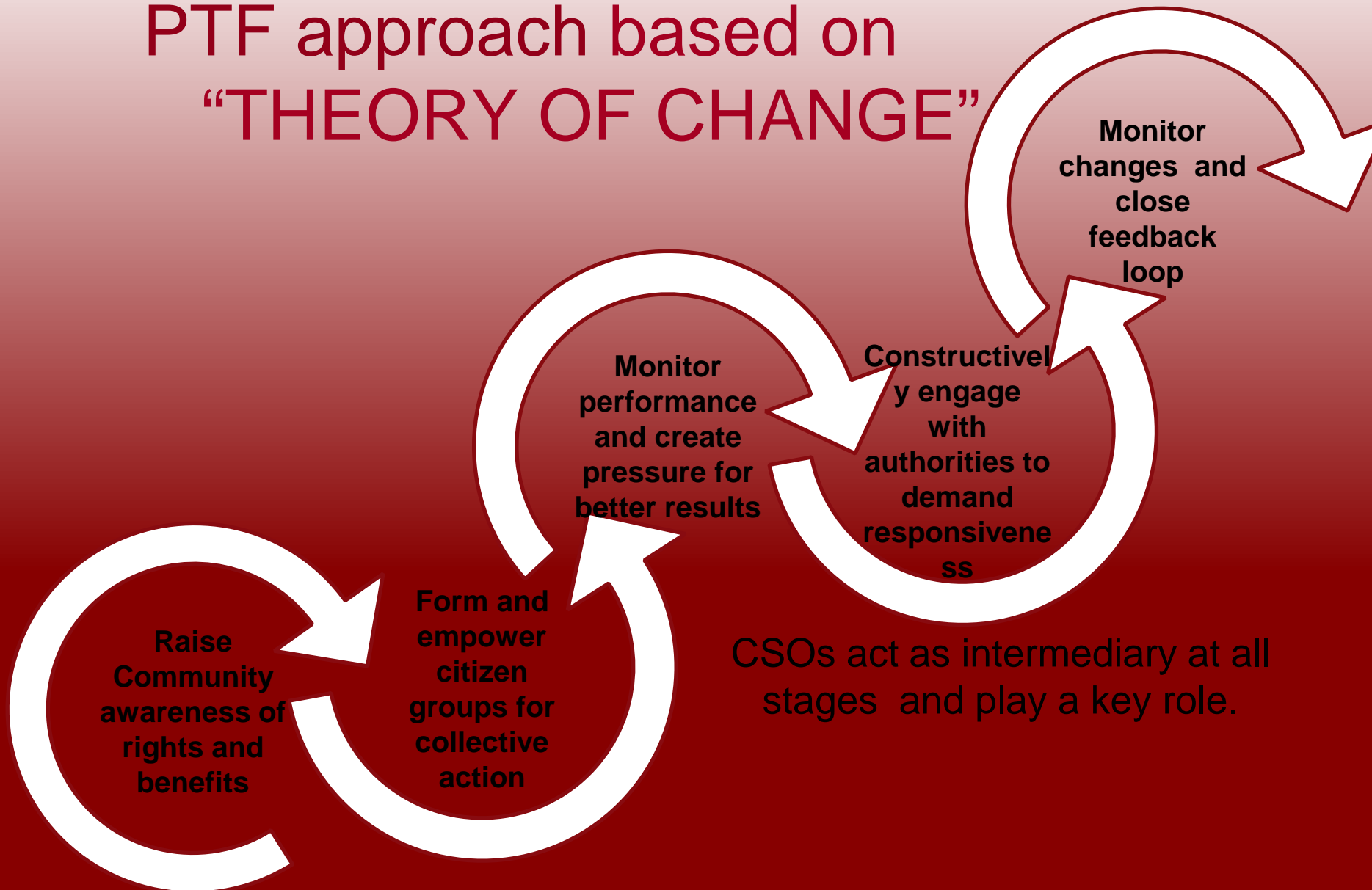
# Theory of Change

accountability, community by community

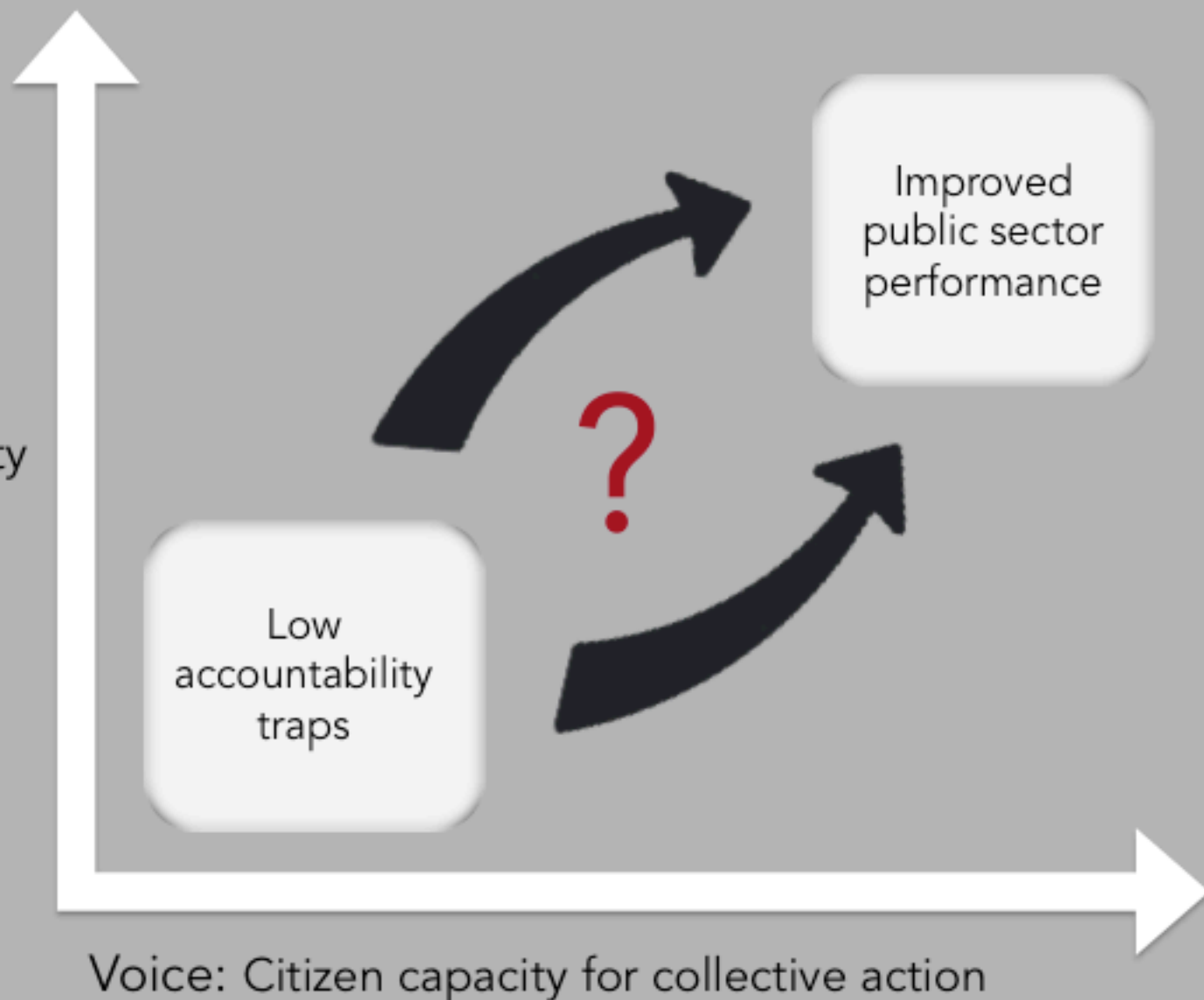


# PTF approach based on “THEORY OF CHANGE”



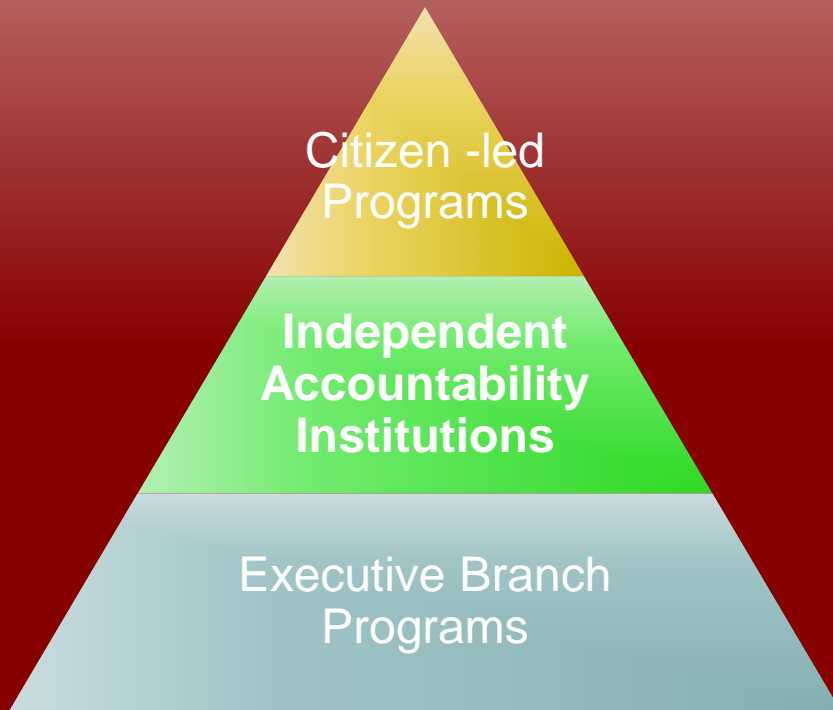
