Support DMCs to achieve **Universal Health Coverage (UHC)**

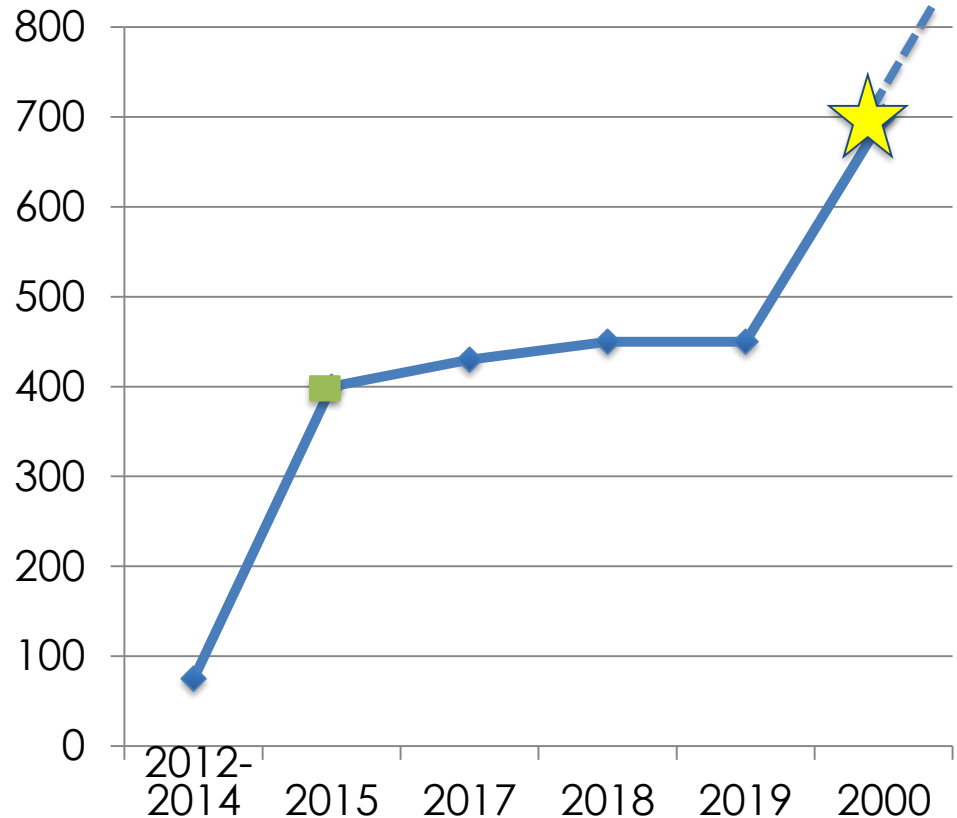

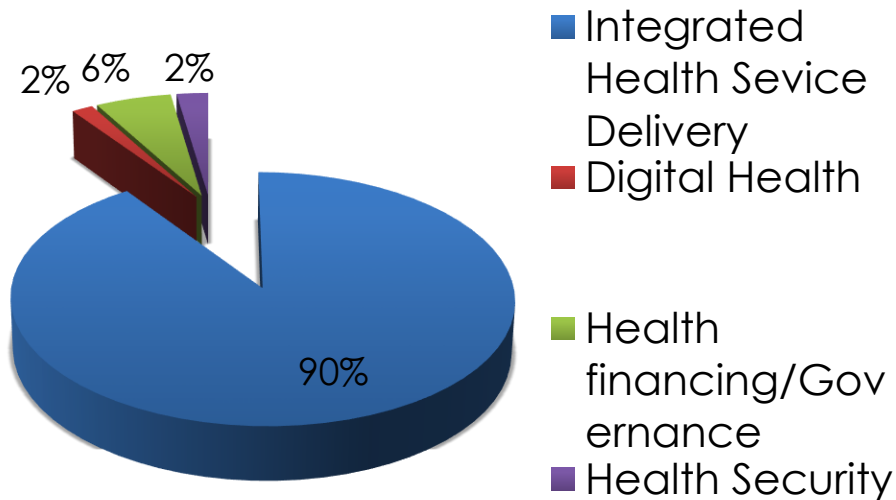

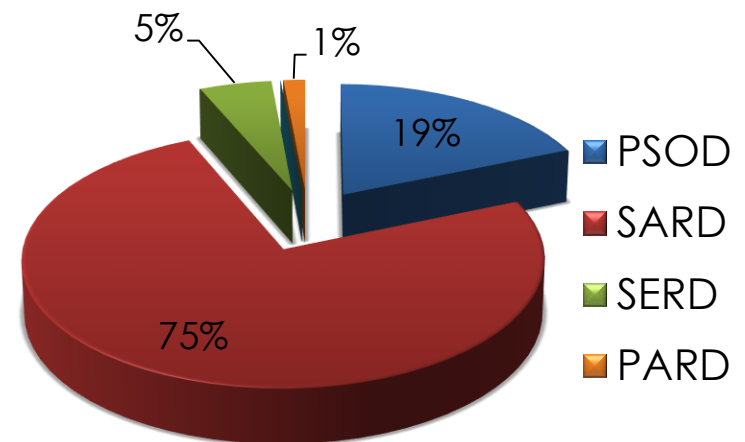

Health projects in 2015 by OPH business lines

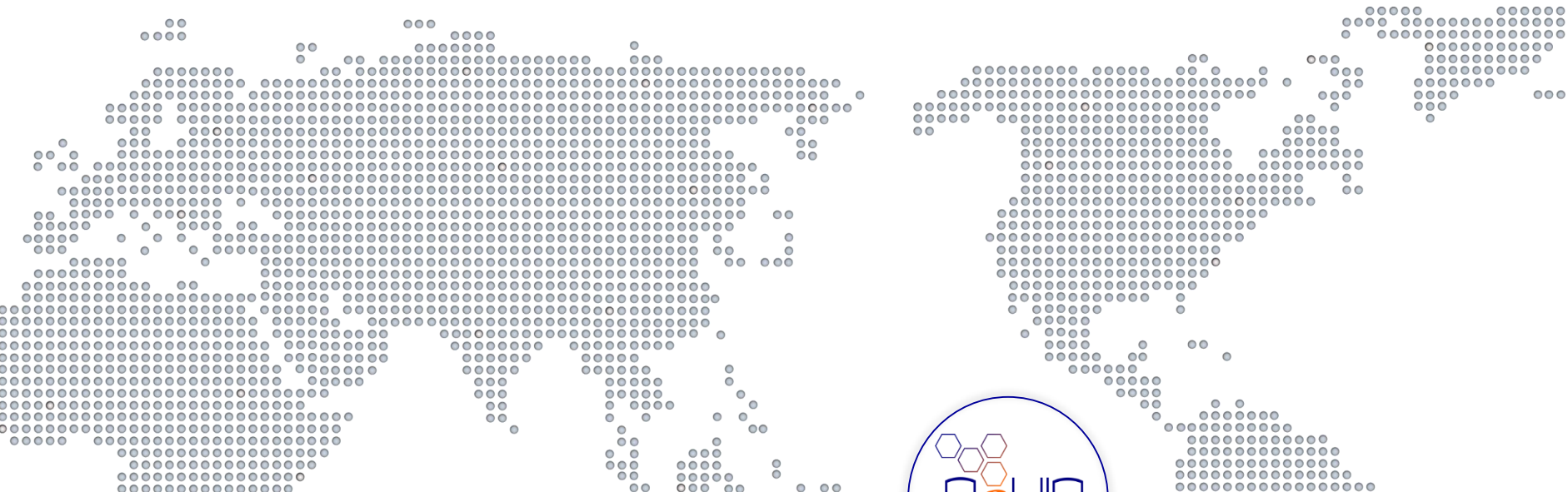


Share of health sector projects by department

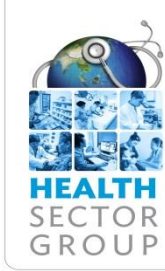

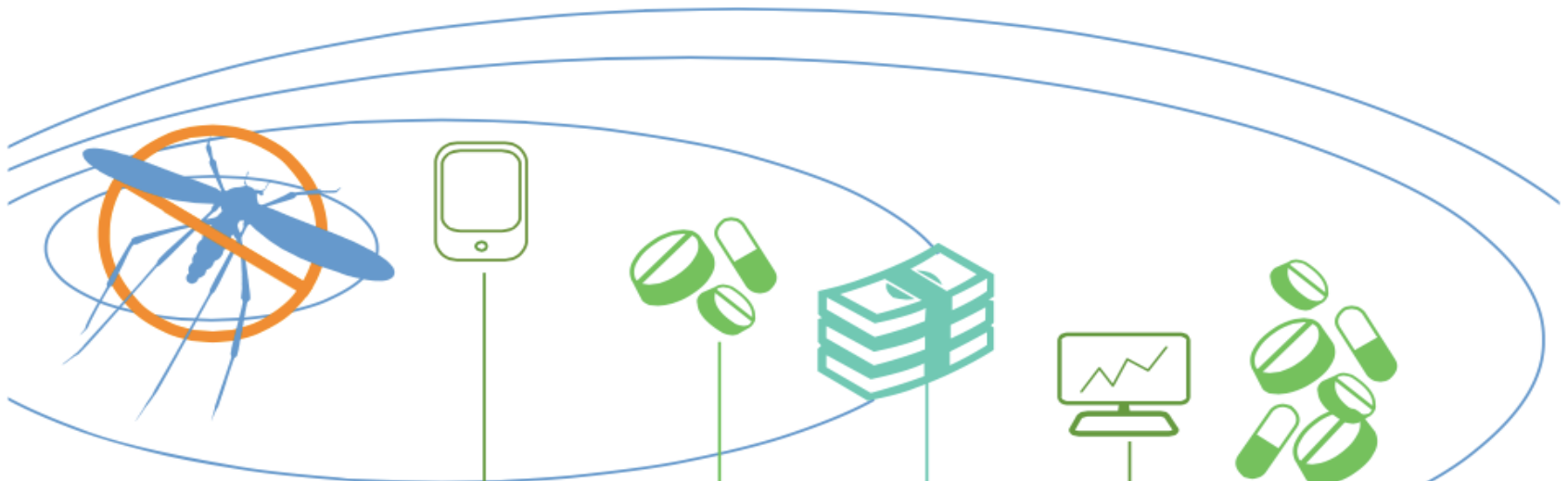

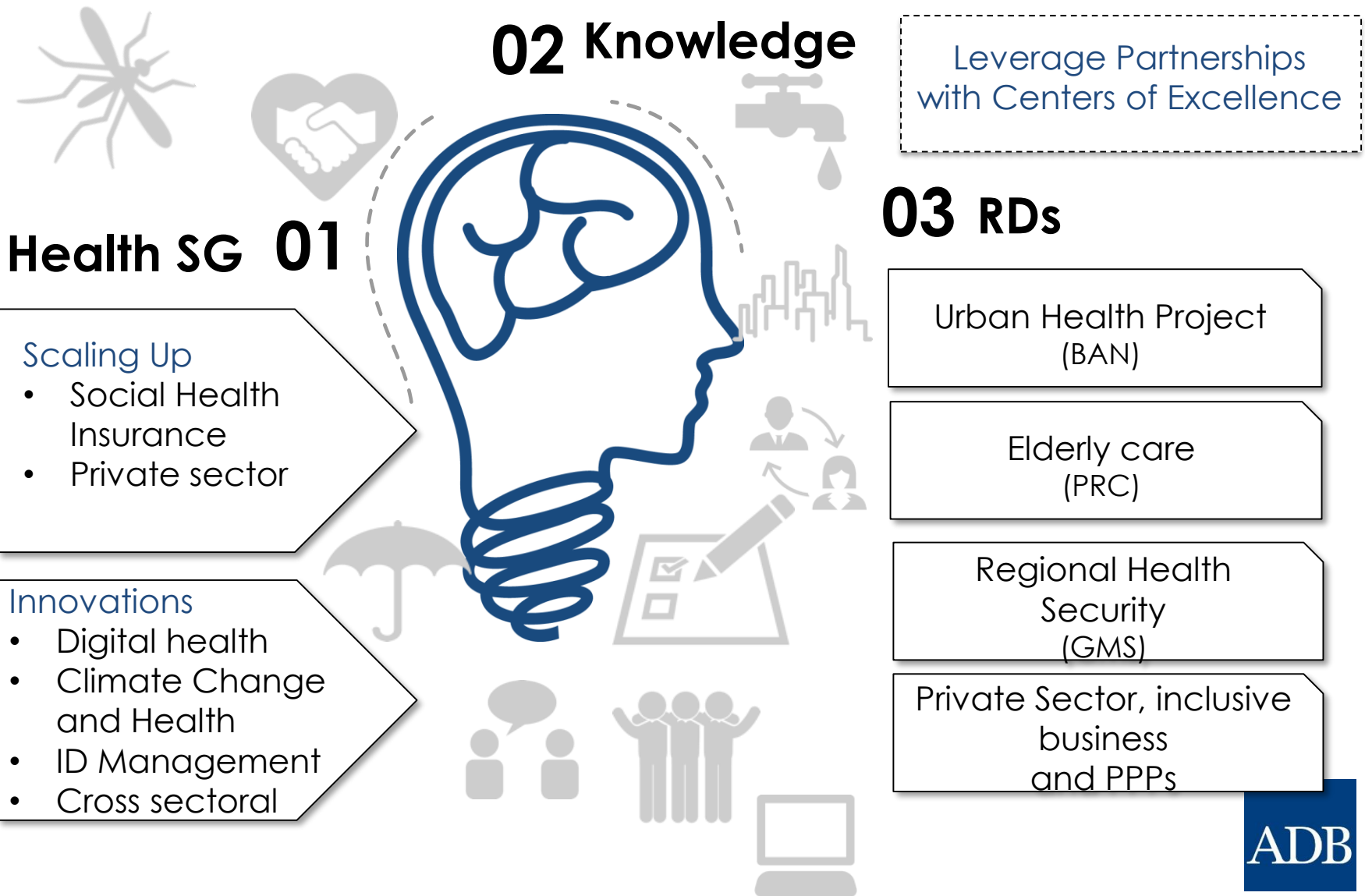
