

Challenges and Opportunities in Education in the Philippines

Challenges

- Secondary school system that does not lead to better labor market outcomes for youth.
- Weak contribution of post-basic education (particularly higher education) to inclusive growth and innovation.

Opportunities

- DepEd to launch in June 2016 the senior HS program (K1-12) in accordance with the Enhanced Basic Education Act RA 10533 and Philippine Development Plan, 2011–2016 Midterm Update.
- Support for youth school-to-work transition program in line with the *Philippine Development Plan,* 2011–2016. There are other opportunities.

Knowledge Partnership

- Identify innovations and good practices in improving learning outcomes and labor market outcomes
- Prepare case studies
- Explore developing knowledge products
- Explore developing capacity development programs building on knowledge products
