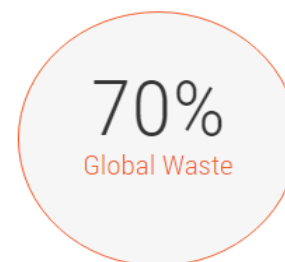
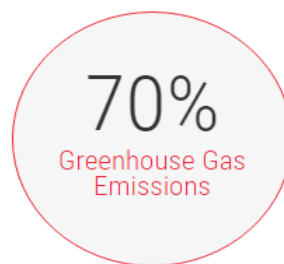
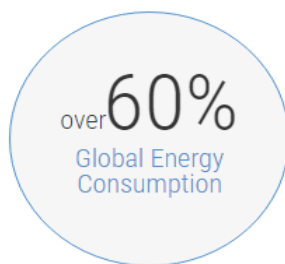
# Make cities and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable.

- Target 11.1:** housing and basic services, and upgrade slums
- Target 11.2:** transport systems for all
- Target 11.3:** participatory, integrated and sustainable human settlement planning and management
- Target 11.4:** world's cultural and natural heritage.
- Target 11.5:** number of deaths, number of affected people and economic losses caused by disasters, with the focus on protecting the poor and people in vulnerable situations
- Target 11.6:** adverse per capita environmental impact of cities
- Target 11.7:** universal access to safe, inclusive and accessible, green and public spaces
- Target 11.8:** links between urban, peri-urban and rural areas by strengthening national and regional development planning
- Target 11.9:** integrated policies and plans towards inclusion, resource efficiency, mitigation and adaptation to climate change, resilience to disasters
- Target 11.10:** Support least developed countries, including through financial and technical assistance, for sustainable and resilient buildings utilizing local materials.

Cities today approximately occupy only 2% of total land

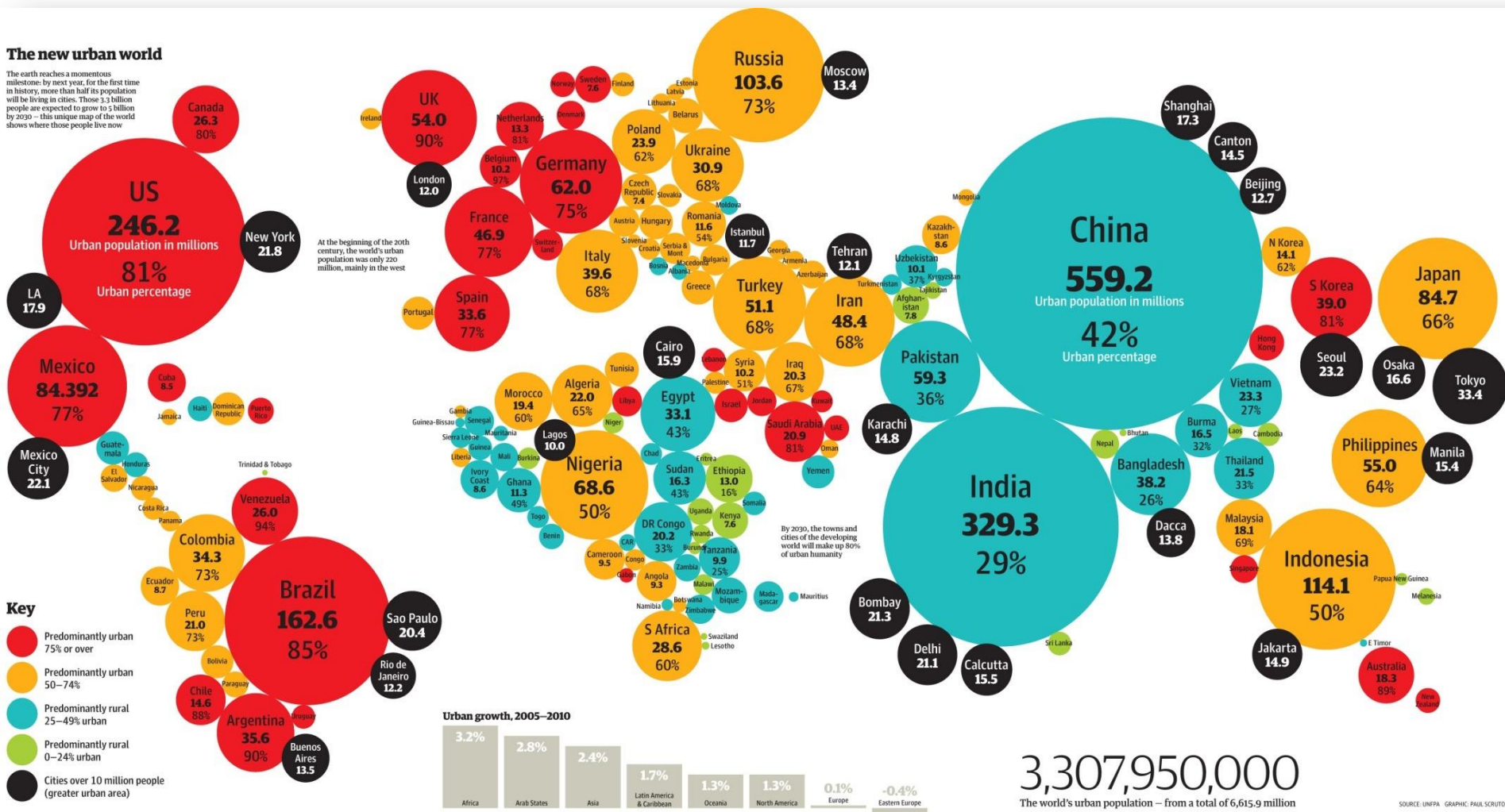




# The New Urban World

## The new urban world

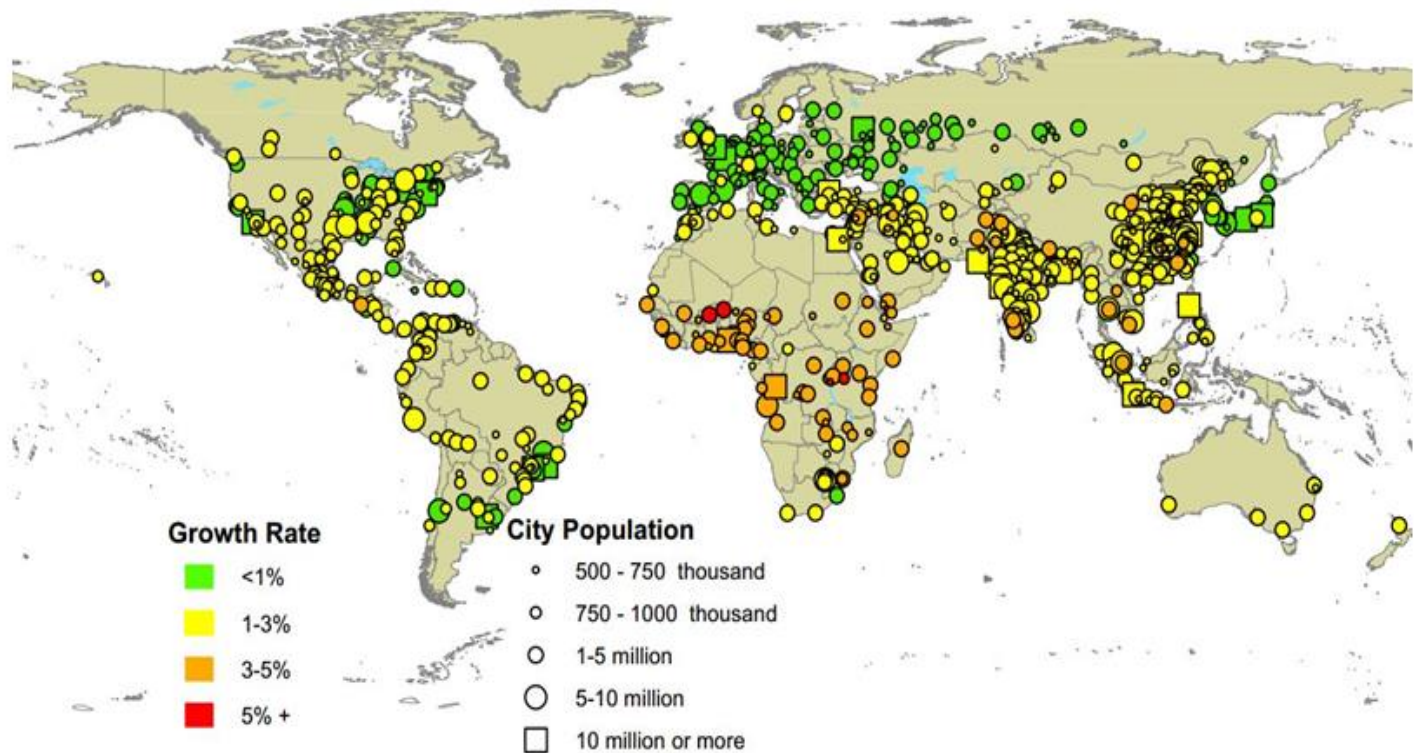

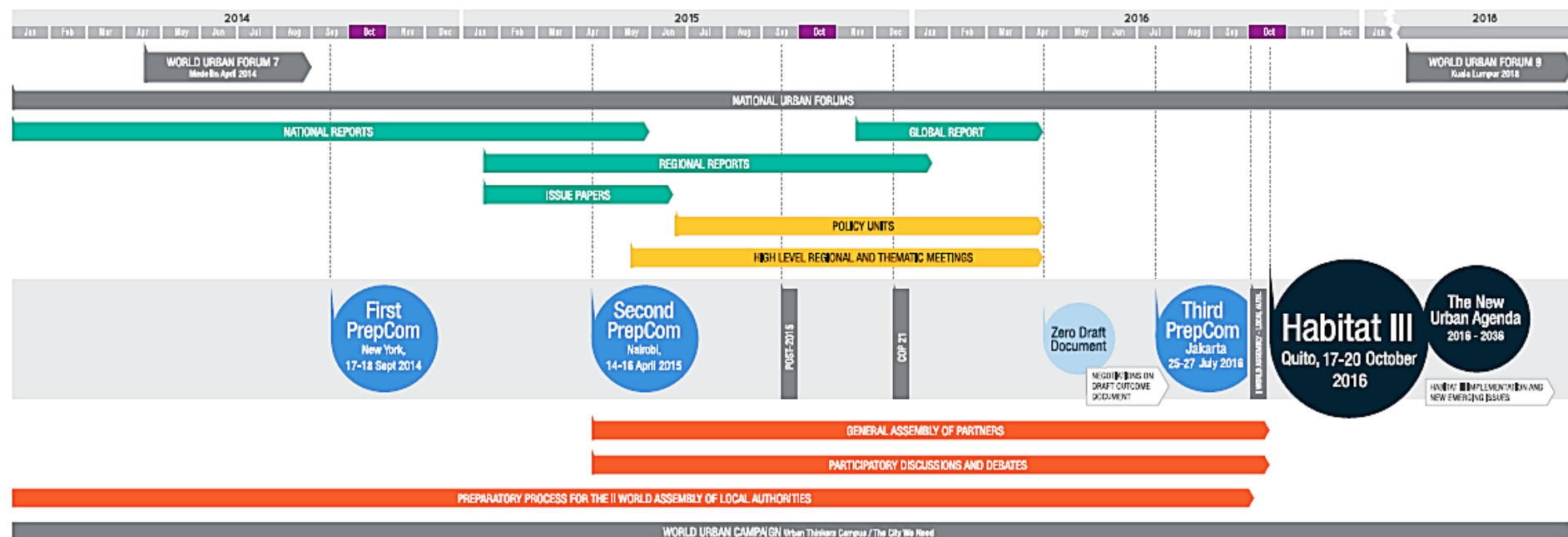

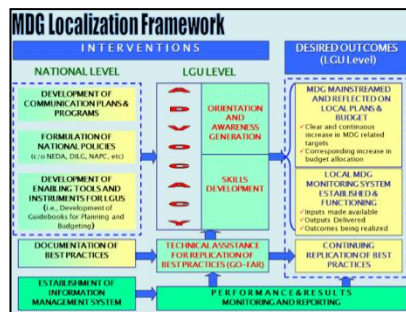


# Strategies to Operationalize

- Means of **implementation** (including access to science, technology, and innovation and enhanced knowledge sharing, capacity development, and mobilization of financial resources)

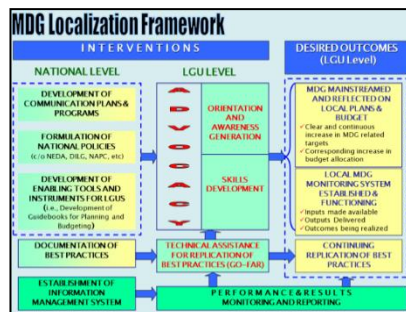
