Funding: Public Transport IT

- ADB TA: PPTA, PATA, CDTA
- Trust Fund : e-Asia Fund/PPIAF
- Loan Project: Part of project component

- Government Funding
- Concession Contract
- Joint Venture : Government + system company

Implementation: Public Transport IT

System cost and revenue

- Installation cost: US13 million
 - SC reader, GPS, CCTV on 1,380 buses, BMS center
- Financing source
 - 100% invested by Korea Smart Card (KSC): bank loan with 2.8% per year
- Revenue source : 10% service fee of cash- and SC-pay fare revenue,
 + UB city compensation for free SC users
- Contract term : 4 years.
 No guarantee on high project risks;
 (foreign exchange rate and forecast revenue)

Implementation: Public Transport IT

Results

- Revenue loss
 - SC users decreased from 48% in Sep 2015 to 34% in Feb 2016.
 - Fare evasion by cash-pay users. It is assumed 33%.
