Vision

Enhance efficiency and transparency in public procurement by way of introducing the state wide coherent procurement policy framework and to implement a single, unitary, end-to-end e-Procurement solution in phased manner to be used by all government organizations in the State including the Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs)

Objective

- To develop state wide comprehensive Public Procurement framework and policy to ensure
 - Enhance transparency in the Public procurement procedures and practices
 - Fair and equitable treatment to bidders
 - Promoting competition
 - Enhancing efficiency & safeguarding integrity
 - Ensuring accountability and improved auditability of public procurement expenditures
 - Enhance public confidence in public procurement
- Implement e-Procurement solution
 - Minimize the procurement cycle time and to improve service levels of all stakeholders
 - To minimise the transaction costs associated with procurement
 - To enhance decision-making capabilities of procurement officials by providing procurement information through MIS and analytical reports

Policy Reforms

- In line with the vision and to meet the objectives, GoR has enacted the Transparency in Public Procurement Act and Rules, 2012 (RTPPA & RTPPR) and subsequent amendments.
- Highlights of RTPP Act
 - Process/procedures to regulate Public Procurement covering
 - Formation of procurement committees based on nature, type, value etc
 - · Annual Procurement Plan and record keeping
 - Different methods of procurement Open competitive, Limited bidding, Single source, Two-Stage bidding, International competitive, etc
 - Bid process management and timeframe
 - Code of integrity for Procuring Entity and Bidders

Policy Reforms

- Provision for Procurement or Price Preference to specific category of bidders
 - As per Socio –economic policy of the state/central government
 - Promote Domestic Industries
- Provision for appeals and penalties/Punishment
- Standardization of Bidding Documents
- Applicable to all Govt. Departments, Corporations, Boards, Societies etc.
- Institutional Arrangements
 - State Public Procurement Portal (SPPP)
 - State procurement facilitation cell (SPFC)
 - e-Procurement

State Public Procurement Portal (SPPP)

Mandatory for all procuring entities to publish all procurement related information on this portal

- Annual Procurement Plan
- All bids above value Rs. 1.00 lacs and its status
 - Bid related general information and Important dates
 - Bid document, Corrigendum etc.
 - Bidders participated
 - List of bidders rejected at each stage with reasons
 - Details of successful bids, their prices and bidder details

State Procurement Facilitation Cell (SPFC)

Major Functions

- Awareness and training about RTPP Act
- Measure and ensure effective implementation of the provisions of Act
- Maintain and update the State Public Procurement Portal
- To study different methods of public procurement and prepare and recommend standard bidding documents
- To encourage procuring entities to adopt electronic procurement

e-Procurement

- As per RTPP Act, e-Procurement has been made mandatory for all state government departments/PSUs for procurement value as decided by State Government time to time.
- Threshold limits:
 - 1st Oct 2011 16th September, 2015
 Rs. 50.00 lacs or above for all Depts/PSUs and for PWD Rs. 25.00 lacs
 - 17th September, 2015 31st August 2016
 Rs 25.00 lacs for procurement of Goods & Services and Rs 10.00 lacs for works.
 - 1st September, 2016 onwards
 Rs 10.00 lacs for procurement of Goods & Services and Rs 5.00 lacs for works.

 Government e-Procurement solution developed by National Informatics Centre (GePNIC) has been implemented in the state.

e-Procurement Portal for State (www.eproc.rajasthan.gov.in) was launched on 1st October, 2011.

Having started with four major departments, the system is now used by more than 165 state government departments/PSUs, which in itself is a key benchmark for the success of the project. The line departments have successfully processed more than 67,141 tenders amounting to more than Rs. 3,05,885 Crores.


