

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

1 Manila Central Sewerage System

- outfall to Manila Bay, no treatment
- **♦** 7 lift stations, 1 pump station
- **♦ 305 km sewer network**
- ♦ 2,620 ha area served

2 Dagat-Dagatan System

- aerated lagoons
- 18 km sewer network
- 333 ha area served


3 Magallanes System

- Activated sludge STP
- 73 km sewer network
- ♦ 600 ha area served


4 Quezon City Separate System

- **♦ 31 communal septic tanks**
- 114 km sewer network
- 1,300 ha area served


Separate Sewer Systems




Septage Management (a.k.a. 'Sanitation')



Combined Sewer & Drainage System with Sanitation Services




Metro Manila East Zone sewer coverage as of Q1 2017



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Revised effluent standards

Limits for Class C water bodies

Parameter	DAO 1990-35	DAO 2016-08
BOD ₅	50	50
COD	100	100
Ammonia	None	0.5
Nitrates	None	14
Phosphorus	None	1

- Transition work to achieve compliance (5 yrs)
 - Need more space, new technology
 - Add'l CAPEX, higher OPEX
 - Non-compliance during retrofit work
- Will it really result in cleaner water bodies?
