


PROCESS FLOW





Type of Request


Percentage of Requests





Best Practices

- Frequent checking of the FOI website for new requests
- Fast processing time
- Provide complete information/data request
- Immediately informs subject matter division of complex requests
- Information mapping

Challenges Faced

- Multiple requests from one (1) requester
- Requests are complex and time consuming
- Requests for large data sets
- Errors encountered on eFOI website
- Coordination with subject matter division
- Volume of requests increase everyday

Notable lessons

- Patience
- Extension of working hours
- Provide time to log in and check incoming request online
- Coordinate from time to time
- Understand the information needed



MOVING FORWARD

- 1150 available data with 8852 data downloads
- Commitment to upload in an open data format
- Creation of a unit handling FOI and normal data requests
- Need for citizen-based services
- Provide manual requests
- Feedback mechanism
- Development of a system for POs and ROs requests; and a system for FOI and normal data requests from clients or the PSA website


