

Regional Implementation of the UNCITRAL Model Law on International Commercial Arbitration

Charter of the United Nations Article 33

- 1. The parties to any dispute, the continuance of which is likely to endanger the maintenance of international peace and security, shall, first of all, seek a solution by negotiation, enquiry, <u>mediation, conciliation,</u> <u>arbitration</u>, judicial settlement, resort to regional agencies or arrangements, or other peaceful means of their own choice.
- 2.The Security Council shall, when it deems necessary, call upon the parties to settle their dispute by such means.
