

Public Financial Management

Public finance (like developing medium-term fiscal framework), budget preparation (including preparing medium-term expenditure framework), treasury functions (budget execution, automation), accounting and reporting (including internal controls and audit)

Debt Management

Legal and institutional framework, debt management and debt management systems

Debt and Securities

Debt issuance practices, strategy for government securities market, review legal and institutional impediments, regulations, devise a communication/market awareness strategy



Opportunities in: (continued)

Capital and Money Markets

Money market infrastructure including legal and regulatory framework, trading platform, audit and accounting practices, strategy for equity and bond markets, drafting prudential regulations, and public awareness campaigns

Pension Reform

Pillar II and pillar III pension systems, strategy, legal, regulatory and institutional setups, pension regulatory authority functions and governance structure, pension fund management, risk management, and communication strategy

PPP
