#### WHY

#### Reason

 Identified the need for a more comprehensive / efficient / structured review of available data

#### Use

- Annual risk assessment: risk ranking of Country Offices
- Audit risk assessment: show potential areas of noncompliance and operational weaknesses, for further review during the audit.
- Audit: consolidated data extraction

#### **HOW – FIRST STAGE**

- Define Controls / Tests (Procure to Pay PO / Voucher)
- Develop UNDP ERP (PeopleSoft) queries
- Develop formulas for defined controls
- Test concept (Excel)
- Automate Process (Excel / Visual Basic scripts)

### **HOW – SECOND STAGE**

- Automate analysis process further
  - Nearly done controls scripted in SQL
- Add additional data sets
  - HR data / Travel data
- Add controls based on fuzzy logic
  - E.g. check vendor data against vendor sanction list
- Improve overall risk scoring
  - Country Office risk scoring

#### RESULT

- Data analytics process and dashboard having 30 controls within 4 categories
  - Compliance: focus on issues where the office has deviated from applicable policies (e.g. where a PO was entered and approved by the same person)
  - Red flag: related controls focus on issues that could indicate fraudulent behavior (e.g. creation of a related requisition, PO and voucher on the same day)
  - Timeliness: focus on issues that could indicate a less than efficient workflow in the office (e.g. a long period between PO creation and approval)
  - Effectiveness: focus on issues that could indicate a sub-optimal use of office resources (e.g. requisitions or PO's that have been created, but have not been used)
- Dashboard has drill down option and provides users with option to extract data
- Dashboard can be accessed online by all auditors

- Frontloading for stronger assurance
- Ability to analyze large volume of data in an efficient manner
- Analyze all data instead of working with samples
- Focus on high risk areas, adding value to audit process
- Identification of cross cutting issues
- Streamlining of audit processes
- Simplified risk rating process

- Improve Result Quality / Expand Machine Learning (supervised learning)


