Gender equality in the Asia Pacific region



- Gender inequality remains challenge in Asia Pacific despite progress
- Declining labor force participation of women (decent work) and remaining gender wage gaps
- Gender issues in emerging global and regional challenges, e.g.,
 - Demographic (aging; youth bulge); technology; migration and urbanization; climate change, disasters, conflict, economic shocks, etc.
- Entrenched gender issues, e.g.,
 - discriminatory laws, social norms, unpaid care work, gender-based violence



Strategy 2030 and Operational Priority 2



- OP2: Accelerating progress on gender equality
- New corporate targets for gender mainstreaming in nonsovereign and sovereign operations of ADB
- <u>5 pillars</u>:
 - Women's economic empowerment
 - Gender equality in human development
 - Gender equality in decision-making and leadership
 - Women's time poverty reduction
 - Women's resilience against shocks



Two types of business opportunities



- 1. Gender-mainstreamed sector lending
 - Transaction TA and project preparation facility (contract via firm)
- 2. Stand-alone gender activities
 - Pilot, capacity building/training, research and studies


