

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

Social Development

A cross-cutting approach to development that promotes

- greater **inclusiveness** and **equity** in **access to services, resources, and opportunities**
- greater **empowerment** of poor and marginalized groups **to participate in social and economic life**
- greater **security to cope with chronic or sudden risks**, especially for the poor and marginalized groups

Key Opportunities – Sample Projects

ADB

Philippines: Proposed Expanded Social Assistance Project 2020 (\$300 million)

PROJECT

- Continue ADB support for conditional cash transfer (CCT) reaching 4.4 million poor households with children
- Extend new support to expanded government social assistance programs, e.g. social pension reaching 3 million poor senior citizens

APPROACH

- Develop more innovative payment systems
- Support demand-driven policy analysis on program eligibility, adequacy of benefit levels, implementation structures, etc.
- Enhance the poverty targeting system



INNOVATION AND VALUE ADDED

- **Exploring fintech solutions for government-to-person payments.** Technological innovation & diversification of payment service providers using new digital platforms could greatly improve timely payment delivery
- **Turning static targeting system into more dynamic social registry** with on-demand application to reduce errors of exclusion and inclusion
- **Linking targeting and payment systems to new unique national ID system** to enhance efficiency and transparency.



Pakistan: Ongoing Social Protection Project (BISP) and Proposed Social Protection Program (BISP 2) 2019 (\$300 million)




PROJECT

- Ongoing ADB support (2013-2020; \$430M) for the Benazir Income Support Program (BISP) is helping to reduce income poverty by providing unconditional cash transfer (UCT) to the female head of poor families. Around 5.6 million households are receiving UCT under the BISP program. UCT is complemented with financing from World Bank and DFID for a conditional cash transfer (CCT) scheme to send children to schools.
- New ADB support (\$300M) to further assist the government to expand and strengthen its social protection program.

APPROACH

- Targeting through poverty score card survey
- Verification through National Socioeconomic Registry (database of 25M households)
- Payments through smart card/mobile banking/debit cards
- Grievance redressal through web-based management information system




INNOVATION AND VALUE ADDED

- **Turning static targeting system into more dynamic social registry** to reduce errors of exclusion and inclusion.
- **Payment methods** converted to **biometric verification systems**.
- **Inclusion components for disabled persons** envisaged.
- **Initiatives piloted to lift people out of poverty.**
 - (i) Business Incubation and asset transfer for self-employment
 - (ii) Inclusive Business among the rural poor through value chains of private sector companies and social enterprises.

Demographic Transition: Adapting to Aging Asia

- **Major social and development challenge for Asia and the Pacific: S2030**
- **Next 15 years is critical time to adapt**
- **New business opportunity with potential for large job creation** where ADB can add value across sectors: social protection, health, education, urban, finance, private sector, NGO, ERCD, ADBI
- **Policy development is happening quickly**, but strategic planning and clear ideas on how best to adapt are lagging
- **Demands a One ADB approach** with multisectoral teams. Many entry points for lending.



PRC Hubei Yichang Comprehensive Elderly Care Demonstration Project 2018 (\$150 million)

PROJECT

Develop a three-tier system of elderly care services (residential, community, home)

APPROACH

Cross-sector approach with the following components:

- (i) Home- and community-based care
- (ii) Dementia care
- (iii) Geriatric hospital
- (iv) EC-ICT platform
- (v) Human resources
- (vi) EC system development

INNOVATIONS

TA – Strategic Plan – PPP Project – Public Sector Project

(i) address unmet urgent needs, i.e., care for elderly with **dementia**; (ii) **digital smart link** to agency providers and beneficiaries by fully leveraging **Yichang Smart City**; (iii) mobilize **private sector's** knowledge, innovation, and financing for

- Scale of demand – residential care
- Gap in supply – between medical and long-term care
