Kyrgyzstan's recorded history spans over 3,000 years, encompassing a variety of cultures and empires. Although geographically isolated by its highly mountainous terrain, which has helped preserve its ancient culture, Kyrgyzstan has been at the crossroads of several great civilizations as part of the Silk Road and other commercial and cultural routes.





 Ethnic Kyrgyz make up the majority of the country's 6 million people, followed by significant minorities of Uzbeks and Russians. Kyrgyz is closely related to other Turkic languages. The majority of the population are Muslims. The size of K-12 population is 1222661= 21%

Schooling survival rates

- In Kyrgyzstan, the gross enrollment rate
 - in Primary education is 106% for both girls and boys combined.
- This decreases to 93% in lower secondary with a student transition rate to secondary school of 99%



Education



- Education in Kyrgyzstan is compulsory for nine years between ages seven and fifteen
- It consists of three stages:
 - Primary
 - Lower secondary
 - Upper secondary
- The overall management of this sector is in the hand of the Ministry of Education and Science.
