



### Challenges faced by ASEAN



- Quality of Education: Poorer countries are less likely to provide the conditions of good quality education, e.g. quality, breadth and freshness of content
- Resource Shortages: The lack of schools and teachers is a big problem in many ASEAN countries; Richer ASEAN member nations have challenges not only to train teachers and build classrooms but to encourage the international community to share best practices.
- Ability to Meet Labor Demands: Work and education mismatch. In the changing workforce environment, maintaining focus on traditional courses no longer works. There is demand for more skilled people in economy-boosting industries.

It is time to rethink and transform educational systems across AS Udemy for Government





- Getting rewards for quality teaching.






