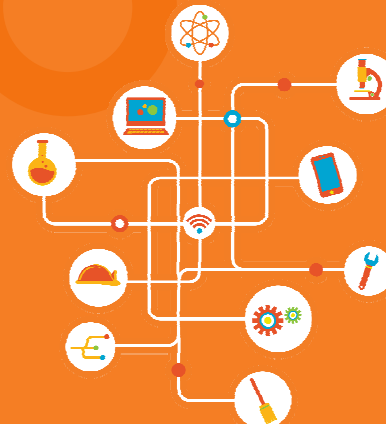

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Definitions

Teacher professional development (TPD)

- Activities that develop and individual's skills, knowledge, and expertise as a teacher (OECD, 2009)
- Structured professional activities that lead to changes in teaching practice and student outcomes

Scale

- Expanding coverage while ensuring depth (Robinson et al., 2016)

Emerging Technologies

- Technologies that cause radical changes in the contexts to which they are applied. Not necessarily new.

- Is the service provided continuously?

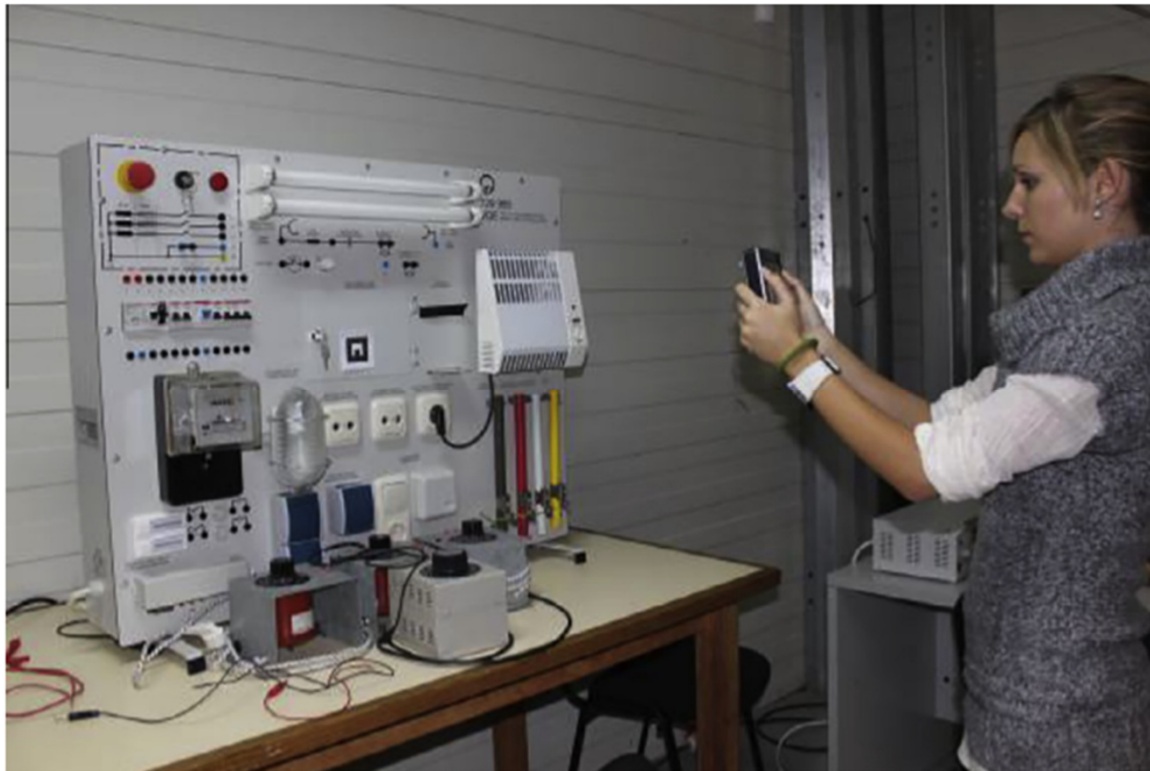
