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Definitions

Teacher professional development (TPD)

- Activities that develop and individual's skills, knowledge, and expertise as a teacher (OECD, 2009)
- Structured professional activities that lead to changes in teaching practice and student outcomes

Scale

Expanding coverage while ensuring depth (Robinson et al., 2016)

Emerging Technologies

 Technologies that cause radical changes in the contexts to which they are applied. Not necessarily new.

Who: the agent who triggers the function


- Who controls the personalization, assessment, and support?

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
