- Through strategic partnerships with companies, government agencies, civil society organizations, and other stakeholders, PDRF synergizes and mobilize efforts towards building disaster resilient businesses in communities across the nation.




- Established in 2018 in Clark Field, Pampanga,
- First private sector-led Emergency Operations Center (EOC) in the world.
- An operational model of a self-sufficient facility for
 - Capability building for disaster preparedness of the private sector members
 - Emergency Operations Center for private sector coordination in emergency preparedness and response during disasters affecting the country.
- 21 EOC Activations , 155 Advisories released to the PDRF Network in 2018

HANDA Powered by PDRF





- Integrates all information on disaster risk reduction
- Serves as a unified platform that enable member companies to assess and reduce their risk prior to disasters.
- Allows companies to plan response and rehabilitation efforts that complement business continuity plans and programs.
