









Finding 3: But Interlinkages Not a Priority Due to Focus on Conventional Environmental Issues



- Implement the 10-year Sustainable Consumption and Production Framework
- Sustainable Management and Use of Natural Resources
- Halve Global Per Capita Food Waste
- Responsible Management of Chemicals and Waste
- 😥 Substantially Reduce Waste Generation
- Encourage Companies to Adopt Sustainable Practices and Sustainability Reporting

- Promote Sustainable Public Procurement Practices
- Promote Universal Understanding of Sustainable Lifestyles
- Supporting Developing Countries' Scientific and Technological Capacity for Sustainable Consumption and Production
- E Develop and Implement Tools to Monitor Sustainable Tourism
- Remove Market Distortions that Encourage Wasteful Consumption



Finding 4: Conventional Environment is a Good Entry Point....




Environment in SDGs Asia-Pacific



SDG = Sustainable Development Goal. Source: Asian Development Bank.





Current Status Environment-Related SDGs








Main Hypothesis: Pilots Using Tools can....
