




EBRD Countries of Operation

EBRD E-Procurement Portal (ECEPP)




- EBRD Client e-procurement portal used for EBRD public sector clients for loan and grant funded procurement under EBRD Procurement Policies and Rules. Fully compliant with IFI e-tendering standards.
- SaaS Contract signed with BIP Scotland on 12 June 2014. Annual licence fee is enterprise wide covering unlimited users and an unlimited number of transactions.
- Cloud-based system allowing use in any Bank member country using any internet browser.
- EBRD project procurement is predominantly for large infrastructure projects and associated consultancy.
- EBRD is the only IFI to offer all its public sector clients a full-cycle e-procurement portal to conduct procurement according to its rules and procedures.
- EBRD Client e-Procurement Portal (ECEPP) has been operating since 2015. Mandatory for all new projects from 2020.

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Egypt – Suez Oil Processing Company Project Key to success:



- Flexible web-based system offered clients a chance to continue their procurement online regardless of where they were in the process.
- Process steps similar to paper processes. Electronic documents similar to paper process
- ECEPP designed for clients very simple dashboards, System prompts, alerts and automatic functions enable client to easily follow Bank rules. Cannot make any key action without a Bank no-objection.
- The system's ease of use meant that clients could immediately use the system with little or no training. Training conducted by sharing live screens in WEBEX, ZOOM, TEAMS.
- EBRD dedicated team for client support. Able to masquerade and provide firstline support and decisions.
- Service provider dedicated team for participant support. 11,000 suppliers registered from 147 countries.
