- Debate on shifting cultivation

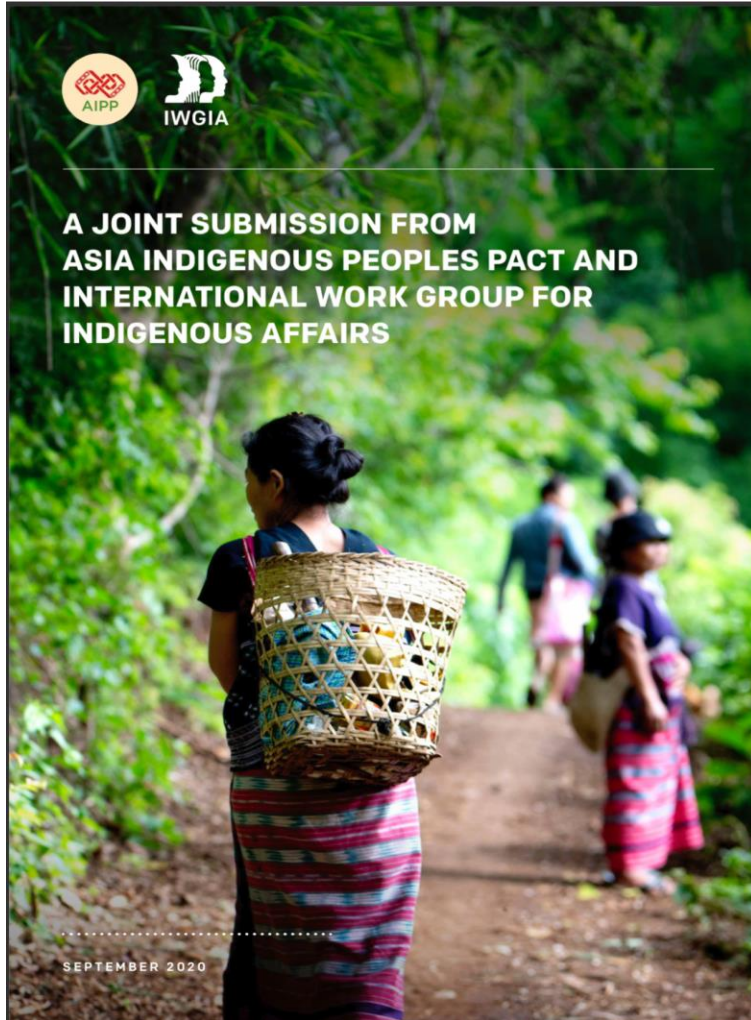


The important of Cancun Safeguards

- Implementation on the ground
- Engagement on the ground
- Benefit sharing (not development assistance)
- Illegal logging (link to other mechanism e.g FLEGT)
- Policy coordination
- Multi-stakeholder collaboration (govt agencies)
- FPIC at national level
- Political will



Recommendation for UNFCCC



- Implement all UNFCCC decisions related to Indigenous Peoples
- Recognize Indigenous Peoples as partners in the protection of biodiversity and climate actions
- Establish Indigenous Peoples' climate platforms at national and local levels
- Revise and implement nationally determined contributions (NDCs) with full participation of Indigenous Peoples including women, youth and persons with disabilities
- Ensure inclusion of indigenous knowledge, customary land rights and governance systems of indigenous peoples as key element in country climate strategies, action plan, policy, NAPA, NDC, NAP
