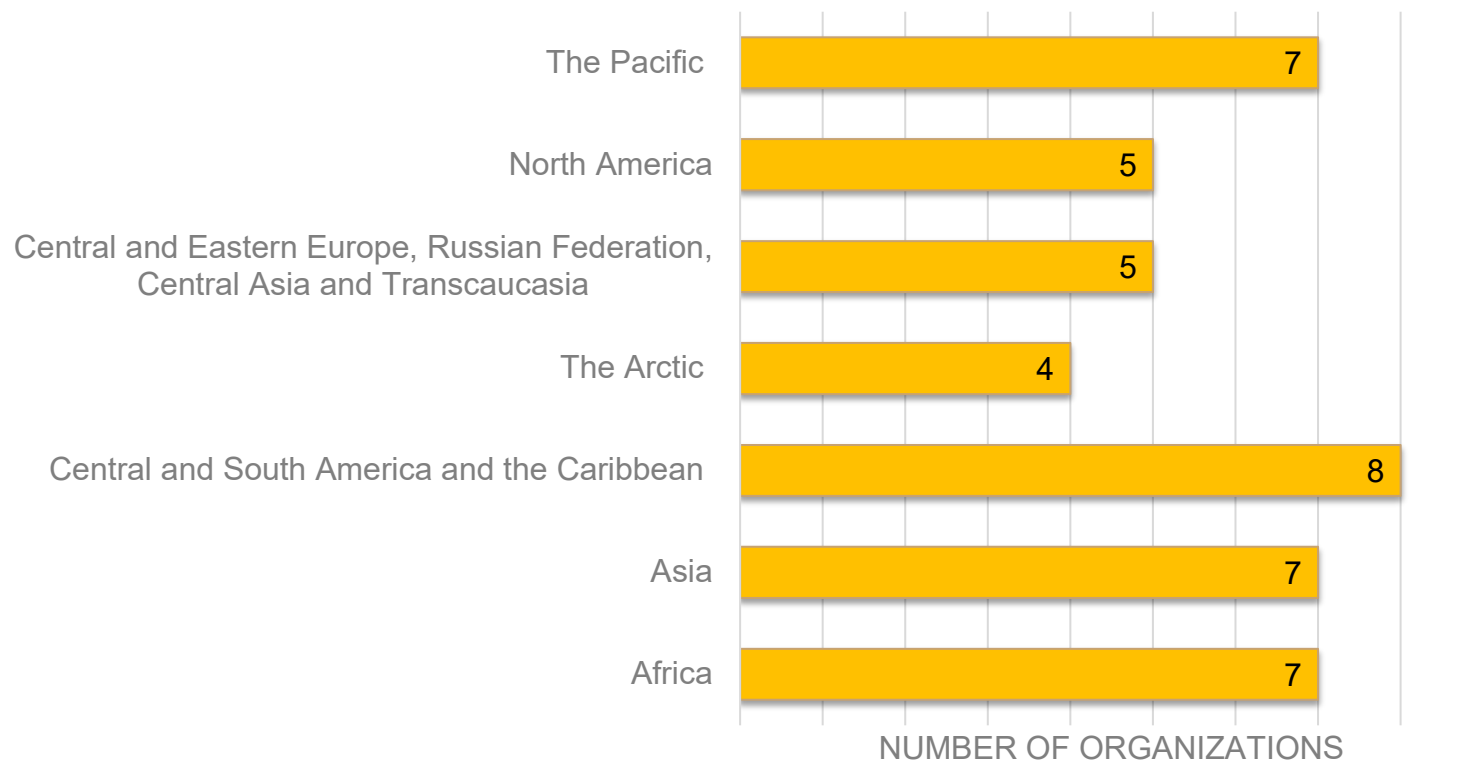
**Number of existing funding opportunities for the participation of indigenous peoples and local communities related to climate change in the UN**



## Geographic distribution of the existing funding opportunities for the participation of indigenous peoples from all regions related to climate change

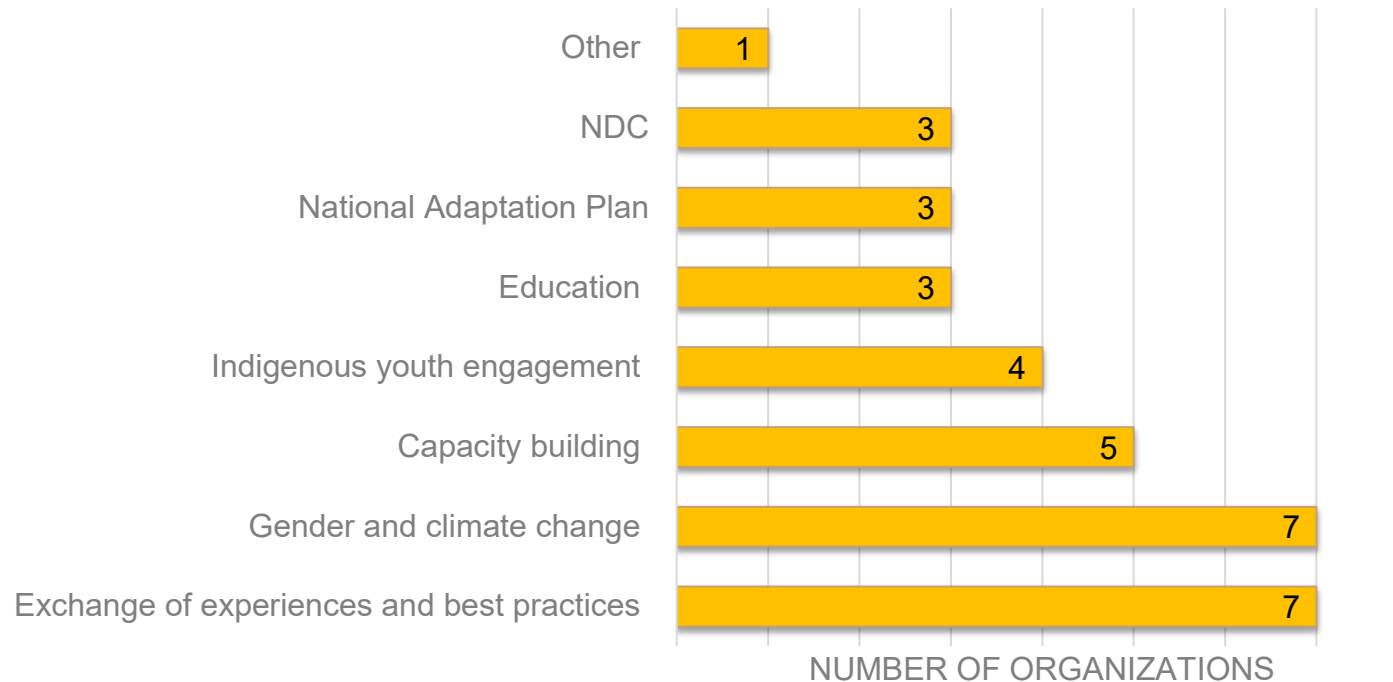

## Thematic distribution of the existing funding opportunities for the participation of indigenous peoples and local communities from all regions related to climate change

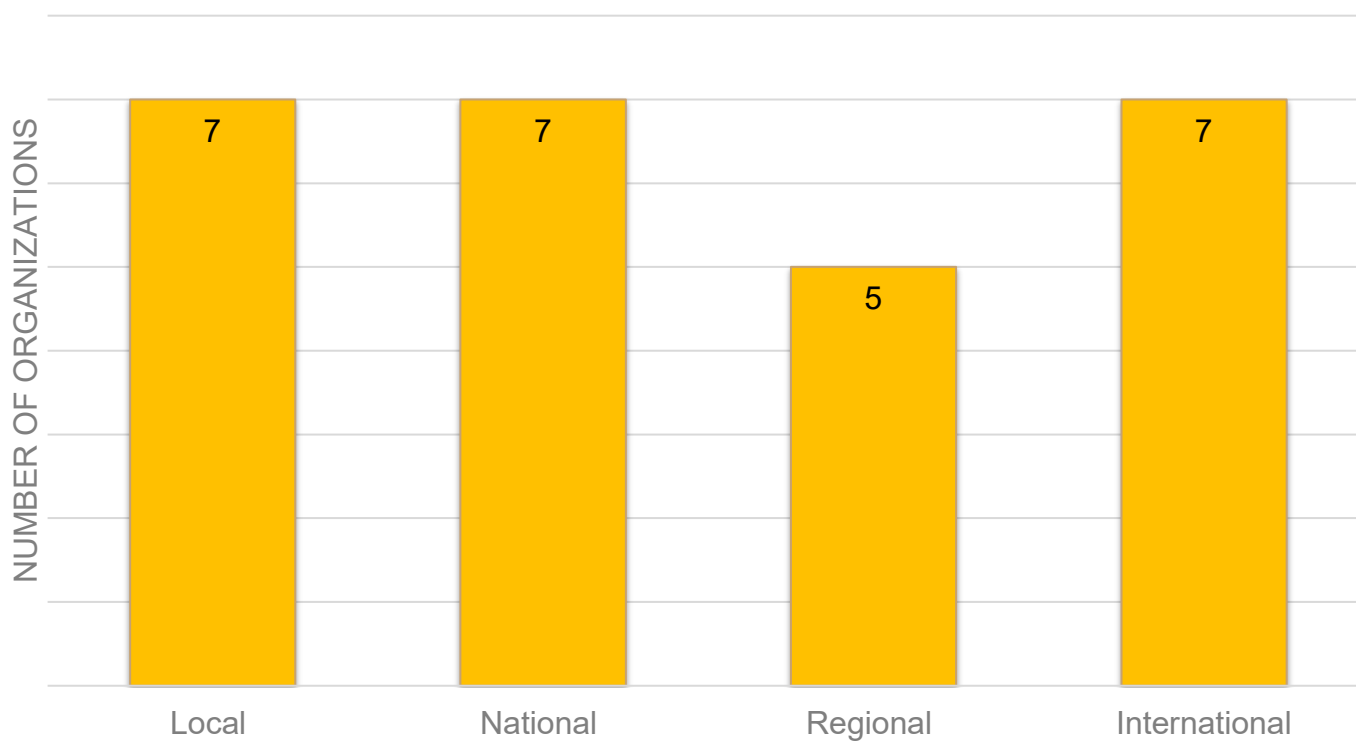
Thematic distribution of existing funding opportunities for the participation of **indigenous peoples** related to climate change



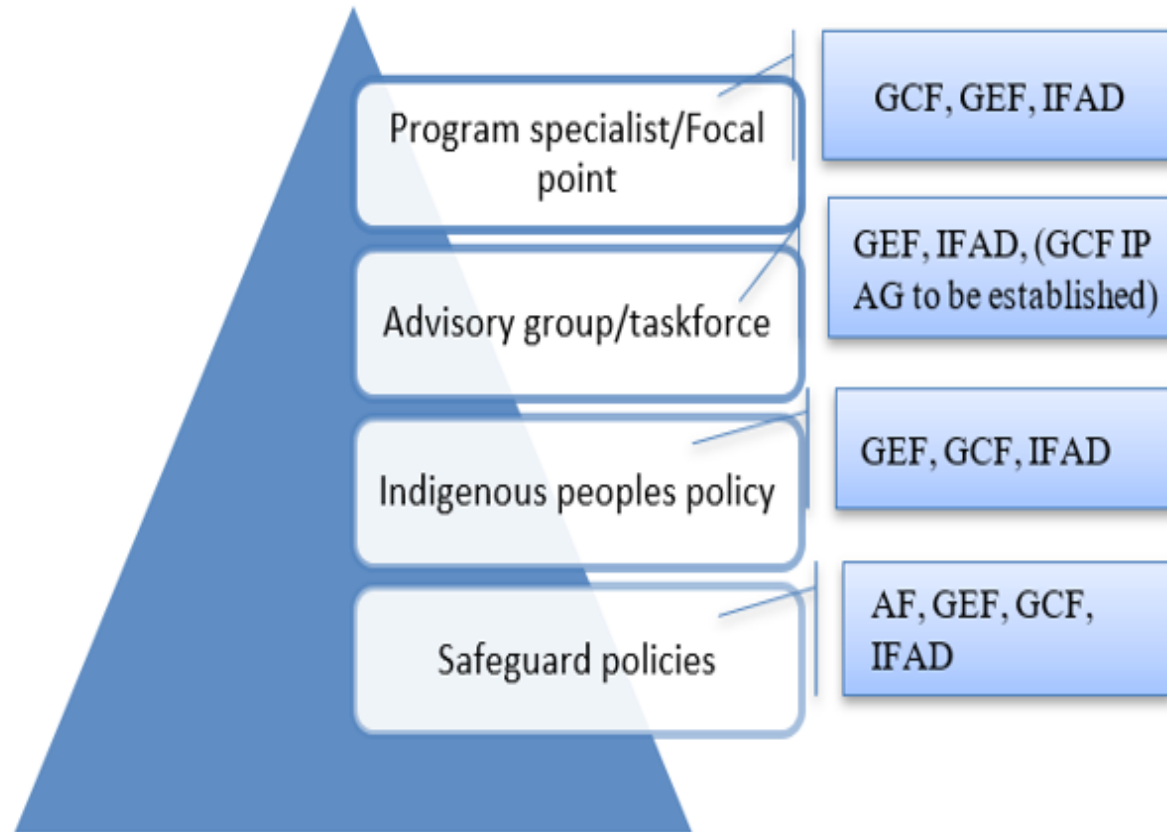
