EFFECT OF LOCKDOWN: WORK STOPPAGE

- Indo-Nepal border closed:
 No Supplies and Workers
- National Lockdown from 24
 March: Labors Returned Home
- Local Govt. implements regional lockdown: Cannot Travel

GOVERNMENT INSTRUCTIONS FOR WORK RESUMPTION

- 2 April- Govt decided to continue construction work
- Ministry issued instruction to resume work observing all safety measures
- ADB supported in preparation of SOP for COVID-19 Risk Management at Workplaces

Steps taken for RESUMPTION of work

- Pass obtained from local administration for project and contractor's vehicles
- SOP was submitted to the district administration offices for approval
- Permission of inter-district movement was provided subject to RDT test clearance

PERMIT FOR INTERNATIONAL EXPERTS

- Entry permit was obtained for the int. experts
- Entry permit was obtained for the contractor's stringing gangs of worker
- Negative PCR test mandatory before departure from the border in Nepal
- Stay in quarantine after entering Nepal
- Travel in project vehicle to project site
- Work in isolation for 14 days



ADHERENCE TO SOP AND CONTINUATION OF WORK

- EA/IA obtained SOP orientation from ADB
- EA/IA provided orientation on SOP to the workers
- EA/IA assured contractor has adhered to all SOP protocols before resuming work
