



COVID-19: TI ASIA PACIFIC CHAPTER ACTIVITIES

Lack of planning and coordination worsen Corona Virus situation in Bangladesh, finds study



Lack of planning, coordination, and mismanagement in identifying and controlling the COVID 19 pandemic along with the country's weak healthcare system due to widespread corruption and long-term neglect towards fundamental human needs put Bangladesh in a

catastrophic situation. In tackling the Corona Virus led crisis, also, lack of transparency and chronic governance deficiencies in government adopted initiatives worsen the situation. The observations came





- Analysis and awareness raising of specific governance and corruption risks
- Advocacy to ensure transparency, integrity and accountability in the COVID-19 response and recovery efforts, and State of Emergency COVID Relief Funding.
- Monitoring COVID19 related procurement, State of Emergency relief funding, and other processes
- **Assistance** for vulnerable communities to access COVID 19 relief funds.


