### **Proactive Integrity Reviews**




OAI conducts proactive integrity reviews (PIRs) on ongoing sovereign projects to mitigate integrity risks.

PIR outcomes further strengthen the accountability of project stakeholders and controls over processes and activities, enhance transparency in documentation and procedures, and foster fairness in procurement processes and decisions.






#### **Contracts Reviewed**





### **Proactive Integrity Reviews**



- Identify projects based on selection criteria
- Notify ADB stakeholders



#### **Detailed Planning**

- Understand the project and determine the review scope and procedures
- Recruit consultants
- Arrange mission logistics
- Inform stakeholders of review requirements



#### Fieldwork and Preliminary Analysis

- Review documentation and conduct interviews
- Inspect project assets
- Analyze and document preliminarily findings and risk implications
- Discuss preliminary findings with the executing and/or implementing agency and ADB's operations department
- Draft the findings and recommendations matrix and seek additional comments



### Detailed Analysis and Reporting

- Draft the report and seek comments from the executing and/or implementing agency and ADB's operations and other relevant departments
- Issue the final report to the executing and/or implementing agency and to ADB's operations and other relevant departments
- Publish the final redacted report on ADB's website



OAI addresses comments and feedback before finalizing the report.







# Red flags: Bribery


- Contract prices were unjustifiably high,
- Particular supplier was directly selected,
- Unnecessary broker was involved in contracts or purchases,
- Third party commissions or fees to agents





# Red flags: Conflicts of Interest

- Unexplained or unusual favoritism of particular
- contractor or vendor
- Contracting personnel failed to disclose conflict of interest
- Close socialization with a contractor or vendor,
- Unnecessary broker was involved in contracts or purchases,
- Third party commissions or fees to agents








# Red flags: Collusive Bidding

- Similarities in bids
- Losing bids did not comply with bid requirements or were poorly prepared.
- Apparent connections between bidders
- Unusual bid patterns
- Losing bidders cannot be located
- Few firms submitted bids
- Allowing an unreasonably short time to respond to bids








### Red flags: Fraudulent Practices

- Specifications are significantly narrow or broad
- Specifications use brand name rather than generic
- Similarity between specifications and winning vendor's product
- Only one or a few bidders respond to bid request
- High number of competitive awards to one supplier
- Discrepancies between information in bid forms and supporting documentation
- Inadequate or apparently altered supporting documentation
- Falsified or unreasonable statements



# Red flags: Bid manipulation

- A qualified bidder was disqualified
- Award of a contract to a nonresponsive bid
- Acceptance of bids with invalid bid securities
- Inaccurate bid evaluation reports
- Inconsistent application of bid evaluation criteria
- Particular line item bids in the bill of quantity appear low or purchased
